- 1. Launchers: Who do you think wrote the Bible? How do you know?
- 2. Worship: Read Psalm 119:25-32. Praise God for His Word that saves us.
- 3. Sermon Reflection: The Source of Scripture, 2 Peter 1:16-21

The Validity of Scripture

- What has happened in your life to cause you to distrust the Bible?
- Why do you trust the Bible to be God's Word?
- What more does God need to do to confirm the Bible as His Word to and for you?

- What are the traditions of the culture that you trust more than God's description in His Word?

4. Kingdom Centered Prayer:

- 1. Worship the LORD for his trusted and timeless Word. Acknowledge His kindness that He would speak to us through His Word so that we may know Him.
- 2. Confess how you have ignored His Word. Confess how it has been dull/boring and how you have lived off of the words of man. Confess badly how it has led you to darkness and confess how you enjoy that conviction because it has brought you back to the light.
- 3. Give thanks to Jesus that he lived in public and before witnesses, so that they could write and testify to what they have seen. Praise Jesus for his words and works to bring salvation to people for thousands of years because of what has been written down.
- 4. Who do you know that ignores the words of eternal life found in Scripture? Whose heart is cold toward it? Pray and beg for the Lord to give them eyes to see and ears to hear, so that they could see the beauty and wonder in the living Word of God.
- 5. Ask the Holy Spirit to make you a person who devours the trusted and true Word of God. Plead with the Holy Spirit that the words found in Scripture would awaken your imagination and wonder to worship God in all of your life.

5. Mission: Invite everyone, everywhere to read the Bible with us. The Bible proves itself.

- Pray. Pray. Pray. Enjoy God. Happy your heart in God. Delight in His Word. Love and have fun with Him.
- Then think into the week and strategize about Bible reading with people each day.
- Trust God to keep His promise to work through His Word.
- Pray. Pray. Pray for changed hearts and lives.
