1. Launchers: By what grid do you think and evaluate all you do?

2. Worship God – John 7:37

Worship the LORD for freely giving wisdom to all who ask in faith. Praise Him, Father, Son and Holy Spirit that by His wisdom and kindness He would dwell even in our hearts through Christ.

3. <u>Sermon Reflection: "Heart Integrity"</u>

Heart Integration

- What does it mean to internalize a perspective?
- Competent pilots practice rare situations in a simulator, how is this example similar to heart integrity? How are we to train as Christians?
- What did the illustration of the compass reveal about our created design? Why is it important for us to remember this?

Immeasurable Worth vs. Heartless Thieves

- Why do we guard anything? What does it reveal if we do guard it, or if we don't?
- How has the essence of who we and the world we live in been both polluted and disintegrated from its original design? Where do you specifically notice pollution and disintegration on display? (Think about both features separately and cumulatively).
- How have you sinned by being casual about what is truly inexpressibly valuable?

The Treasure of Wisdom & Knowledge

- What is the goal for someone who trusts Jesus? Why is the *guarantee* of faith in Him so reassuring?
- How was Jesus both polluted and disintegrated so that we could be made clean and whole?
- What daily disciplines have you put in place to guard your heart and internalize Christ? How can we remember that our hearts are worth guarding, especially seen in Christs sacrifice to save them?

4. Kingdom Centered Prayer: You Can Pray with Us

1. Worship the LORD for freely giving wisdom to all who ask in faith. Praise Him, Father, Son and Holy Spirit that by His wisdom and kindness He would dwell even in our hearts through Christ.

2. How have you failed to guard your heart from folly so that you have trashed what is precious and you've held dear what is worthless? Confess your folly and destructiveness to Jesus, asking Him to forgive you and to restore you.

3. Give thanks to Jesus for entering into the deepest darkness of the Cross to cleanse you of your sin. And thank Him that by His resurrection He is the source of light and life, *worked right into your heart by His indwelling Spirit*.

4. Who do you know that lives foolishly, neglecting to guard their heart? Pray for them, asking the Lord to have mercy upon them and to save them from their perilous condition.

5. Ask the Holy Spirit to grow in you the regular practices of forming Jesus' character in you by His means of Grace. Pray for faithfulness in daily repenting and believing the Gospel, daily dying to your self and trusting Jesus to work in your heart as only He can.

5. <u>Mission:</u> Our mission as Christians is to remember that our hearts belong to God, so our first business in our day must be too happy the essence of who we are in Him—through His Word, through prayer, and in community.
