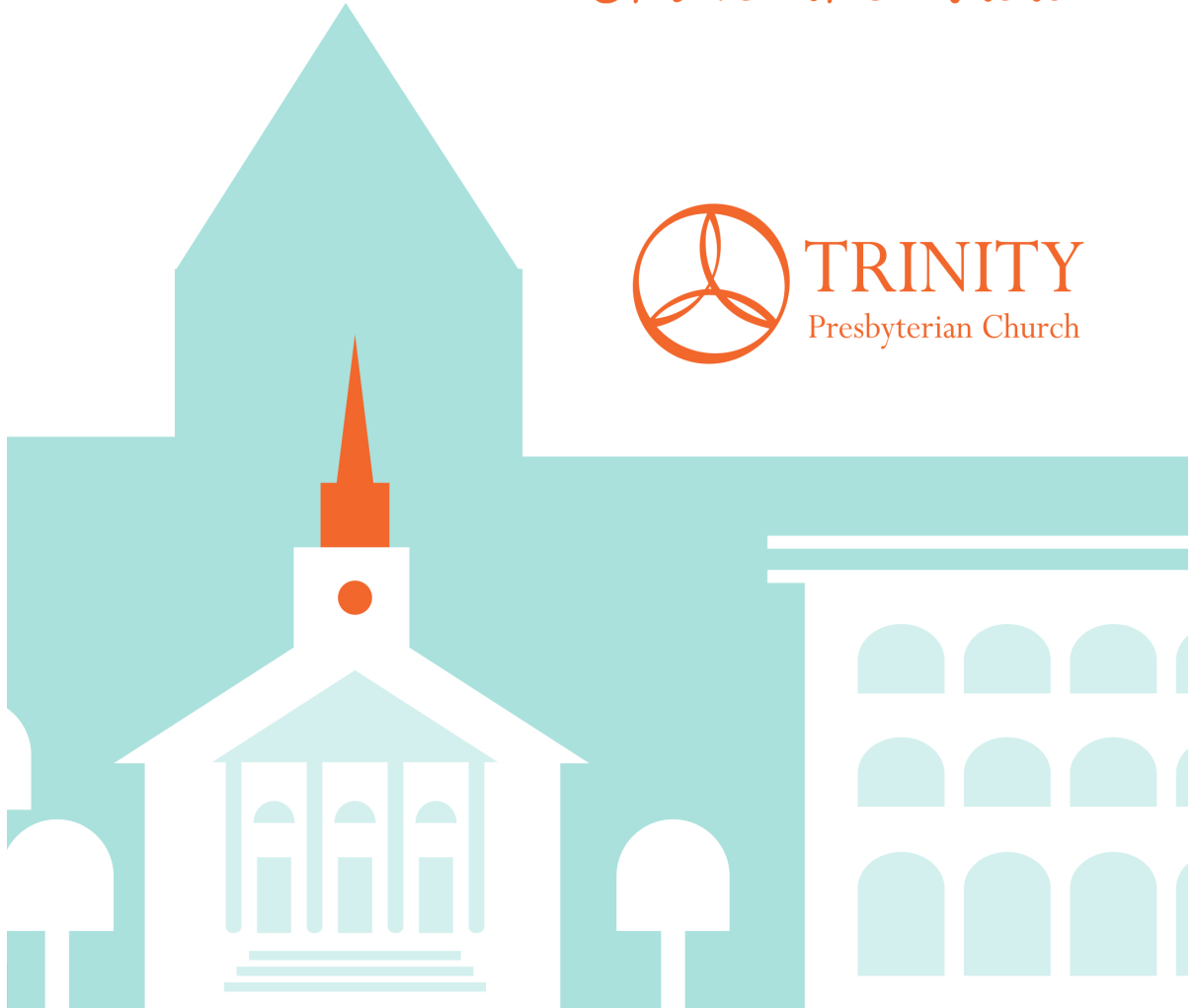

Call to Worship

Ezekiel 34:12-15 (ESV)

As a shepherd seeks out his flock when he is among his sheep that have been scattered, so will I seek out my sheep, and I will rescue them from all places where they have been scattered on a day of clouds and thick darkness. And I will bring them out from the peoples and gather them from the countries, and will bring them into their own land. Confession of Faith

As an expression of our faith in Jesus Christ in solidarity with his people, we declare the substance of what we believe.

The Apostle's Creed:

I believe in God the Father Almighty, Maker of heaven and earth. I believe in Jesus Christ, his only Son, our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, and born of the virgin Mary. He suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified dead and buried; he descended into hell. The third day he rose again from the dead. He ascended into heaven and is seated at the right hand of God the Father Almighty. From there he will come to judge the living and the dead. I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy catholic church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting. Amen.

Sacrament of the Lord's Supper

The ritual meal of Communion is a sign and seal of the grace we have in Jesus. That is, it symbolizes the work Christ did for our salvation (sign) and communicates the grace and mercy we have been given (seal) as a result of His death and resurrection.

Seasons of the Cross

The color green: a sign of life. In the plant kingdom, growth within an organism extends outward into tender green shoots, culminating in a blossom of life as a plant goes to seed, multiplying itself over and over again. On the cross, green is a symbol of the ongoing work of Christ in our hearts. Starting with the smallest seed, His work grows in us over a lifetime, shooting tendrils outward into the lives of others as His kingdom grows. Christ's work is ongoing, vibrant and alive in the hearts of His people.

Scripture Passage and Sermon Outline

Proclamation of God's Word

Text: Psalm 23 (ESV)

Title: The LORD Is My Shepherd

Teacher: Tim Rice

¹ The Lord is my shepherd; I shall not want. ² He makes me lie down in green pastures. He leads me beside still waters. ³ He restores my soul. He leads me in paths of righteousness for his name's sake. ⁴ Even though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil, for you are with me; your rod and your staff, they comfort me. ⁵ You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies; you anoint my head with oil; my cup overflows. ⁶ Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me all the days of my life, and I shall dwell in the house of the Lord forever.

Intro: How can familiar words get stale or dull?

THE LORD IS A SHEPHERD

Why does it matter that the LORD is a shepherd? (And what is life like without a shepherd, according to Jesus?)

IS HE YOUR SHEPHERD?

Why does it matter that He is MY shepherd?

DO YOU LIVE IN WANT?

What changes if the LORD is your shepherd? “I shall not want.”

YOU CAN PRAY WITH US...

1. Worship the LORD, God Almighty for His faithful and gentle care. Praise Him, Father, Son and Holy Spirit for faithfully and lovingly watching over you and all your needs.
2. Read Matthew 9:36. How are you living as if you're harassed and helpless, like a sheep without a shepherd? Confess your unbelief to Jesus, asking Him to wash you and forgive you as your Savior and Shepherd.
3. Give thanks to Jesus for the beauty of His work, that even though He is the Good Shepherd, He became a lamb to be slain to save people like us. Thank Him for committing to be your God so that you could be His sheep.
4. Who do you know that is vulnerable or harassed like a sheep with no shepherd? Pray for them asking the Lord to convey to them a sense of His Presence and grace.
5. Ask the Spirit to bear in you the fruit of joy, especially if He is your Shepherd and that He meets all your needs so that you have no want. Pray that He would persuade you that in Christ you truly belong to Him and cannot be snatched from His hand.
