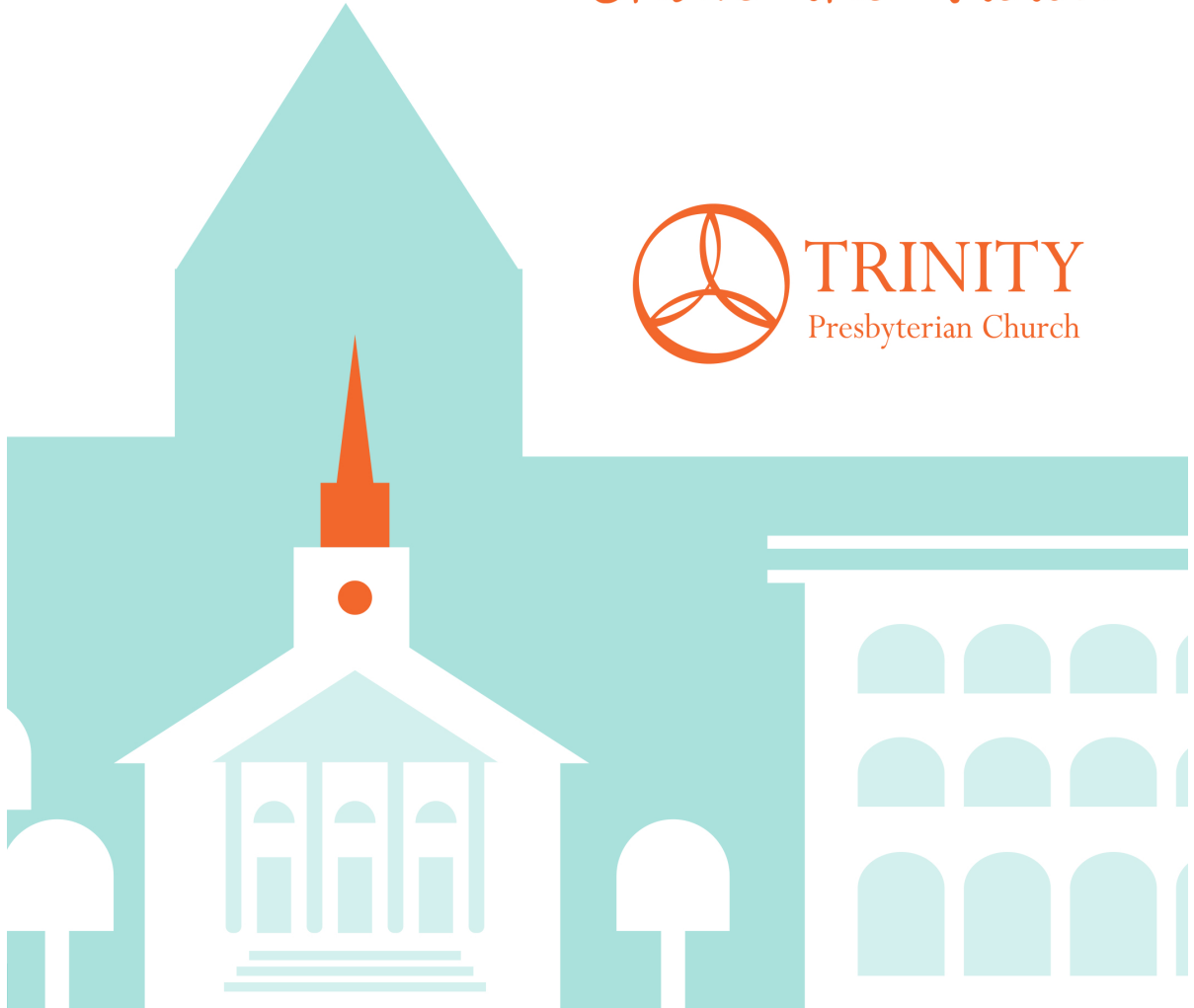

Confession of Faith

As an expression of our faith in Jesus Christ in solidarity with his people, we declare the substance of what we believe.

From the Heidelberg Catechism:

Q. 76. What does it mean to eat the crucified body of Christ and to drink his shed blood?

A. It means to accept with a believing heart the whole passion and death of Christ, and by it to receive forgiveness of sins and eternal life. In addition, it means to be united more and more to his blessed body by the Holy Spirit dwelling both in Christ and in us that, although he is in heaven and we are on earth, we are nevertheless flesh of his flesh and bone of his bone, always living and being governed by one Spirit, as the members of our bodies are governed by one soul.

Seasons of the Cross

The color green: a sign of life. In the plant kingdom, growth within an organism extends outward into tender green shoots, culminating in a blossom of life as a plant goes to seed, multiplying itself over and over again. On the cross, green is a symbol of the ongoing work of Christ in our hearts. Starting with the smallest seed, His work grows in us over a lifetime, shooting tendrils outward into the lives of others as His kingdom grows. Christ's work is ongoing, vibrant and alive in the hearts of His people.

Scripture Passage and Sermon Outline

Proclamation of God's Word

Text: Psalm 23 (ESV)

Title: "The Shepherd Drives Out Fear"

Teacher: Stan McMahan

¹ The LORD is my shepherd; I shall not want. ² He makes me lie down in green pastures. He leads me beside still waters. ³ He restores my soul. He leads me in paths of righteousness for his name's sake. ⁴ Even though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil, for you are with me; your rod and your staff, they comfort me. ⁵ You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies; you anoint my head with oil; my cup overflows. ⁶ Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me all the days of my life, and I shall dwell in the house of the LORD forever.

Intro: Would you agree that we live in an "age of fear"? How can we be delivered from fear?

The Valley of Deep Darkness

What is the "valley of the shadow of death"? Why does everyone have to walk through it? What effect does it have on us?

Fear No Evil

What are our common responses to fear? Why do these responses fail to bring us the freedom we're looking for?

God with Us

How does Christ's coming to dwell with us as our Shepherd drive out fear? Do you live as though He is with you always?

YOU CAN PRAY WITH US...

1. Worship the LORD, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, for His ownership of and care for all things in creation. Wonder at the truth that nothing is outside His Fatherly control!
2. How have you lived dominated by fear? How have you tried to find refuge in your own resources and in other created things? Confess your stubbornness to Jesus, asking Him to recover you, wash you, and restore you to your Shepherd's flock.
3. Give thanks to Jesus for joining you in your sin and suffering so that you could be restored to relationship with God forever. Praise Him that through His death and resurrection He is with you through everything in life.
4. Who in your life is struggling to find meaning and hope in suffering? Ask God to open their eyes to see the light of Christ (God with us) in the valley of darkness.
5. Ask the Holy Spirit to give you a personal experience of God's presence with you because of Christ's work on your behalf. Reflect on God's promise (Isaiah 43:1-7) to be with us as you pray.
