Seasons of the Cross

Black for Lent: The weeks from Ash Wednesday leading up to Palm Sunday on the church calendar have historically been set aside as a time to reflect and ponder the crushing weight of our sin, which is inescapable but for Christ. Black for mourning – a representation of our imminent spiritual and physical death apart from Christ. How wonderful, how marvelous that though our sin was great, His grace was greater – and the story does not end there.

"For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord." Romans 6:23 (ESV)

Scripture Passage and Sermon Outline

Proclamation of God's Word

Text: Luke 12:13-21 (ESV)

Title: The Seven Deadly Sins: Greed

Teacher: Tim Rice

¹³ Someone in the crowd said to him, "Teacher, tell my brother to divide the inheritance with me." ¹⁴ But he said to him, "Man, who made me a judge or arbitrator over you?" ¹⁵ And he said to them, "Take care, and be on your guard against all covetousness, for one's life does not consist in the abundance of his possessions." ¹⁶ And he told them a parable, saying, "The land of a rich man produced plentifully, ¹⁷ and he thought to himself, 'What shall I do, for I have nowhere to store my crops?' ¹⁸ And he said, 'I will do this: I will tear down my barns and build larger ones, and there I will store all my grain and my goods. ¹⁹ And I will say to my soul, "Soul, you have ample goods laid up for many years; relax, eat, drink, be merry."' ²⁰ But God said to him, 'Fool! This night your soul is required of you, and the things you have prepared, whose will they be?' ²¹ So is the one who lays up treasure for himself and is not rich toward God."

Intro: How does my view of God affect how I think about possessions?

THE ULTIMATE PROBLEM

What is greed? It is faith in possessions, unbridled (like kudzu).

THE ULTIMATE SOLUTION What does it mean, "Your soul will be required of you"?

JUST & GENEROUS

What does it mean to be rich toward God?

YOU CAN PRAY WITH US...

- 1. Worship the LORD that He has given us nothing less than His Son on the Cross and His Spirit to live in us. Praise Him, Father, Son and Holy Spirit for His generosity, especially in light of our greed and selfishness.
- 2. How have you lived loving things more than your neighbor, and loving yourself more than God? Confess your arrogance and self-inflation to Jesus, asking Him to forgive you and to change you to be genuinely loving.
- 3. Give thanks to Jesus when His life was required of Him, to save us, He did not hesitate to give. Thank Him for letting go of His privileges to bless us when we've forfeited any rights to any wealth or any privilege.
- 4. Who do you know that struggles with greed (and they don't have to be wealthy)? Pray for them, asking the Lord to help them to see His generosity and grace, and to turn from their selfish way of living.
- 5. Ask the Holy Spirit to bear in you the fruit of love and joy. Pray that He would help you to be so filled with God's lavish generosity toward you that, overflowing with His love, you'd grow more and more generous.
