

Call to Worship

We read God's Word, the Bible, together. It reveals to us who God is and what He expects of us.

I Timothy 6:6-11, 17-19 (ESV)

But godliness with contentment is great gain, for we brought nothing into the world, and we cannot take anything out of the world. But if we have food and clothing, with these we will be content. But those who desire to be rich fall into temptation, into a snare, into many senseless and harmful desires that plunge people into ruin and destruction. For the love of money is a root of all kinds of evils. It is through this craving that some have wandered away from the faith and pierced themselves with many pangs. But as for you, O man of God, flee these things. Pursue righteousness, godliness, faith, love, steadfastness, gentleness...As for the rich in this present age, charge them not to be haughty, nor to set their hopes on the uncertainty of riches, but on God, who richly provides us with everything to enjoy. They are to do good, to be rich in good works, to be generous and ready to share, thus storing up treasure for themselves as a good foundation for the future, so that they may take hold of that which is truly life.

Prayer of Adoration and Confession - John Tucker

We pray together praising God for who He really is (Adoration) and admitting our inability to live up to what He expects of us (Confession).

Assurance of Pardon

We again read God's Word together and are reminded that mercy and grace are freely given to all who have faith in Jesus Christ. Philippians 3:7-14 (ESV)

But whatever gain I had, I counted as loss for the sake of Christ. Indeed, I count everything as loss because of the surpassing worth of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord. For his sake I have suffered the loss of all things and count them as rubbish, in order that I may gain Christ and be found in him, not having a righteousness of my own that comes from the law, but that which comes through faith in Christ, the righteousness from God that depends on faith—that I may know him and the power of his resurrection, and may share his sufferings, becoming like him in his death, that by any means possible I may attain the resurrection from the dead. Not that I have already obtained this or am already perfect, but I press on to make it my own, because Christ Jesus has made me his own. Brothers, I do not consider that I have made it my own. But one thing I do: forgetting what lies behind and straining forward to what lies ahead, I press on toward the goal for the prize of the upward call of God in Christ Jesus.

Seasons of the Cross

White: "Though your sins are like scarlet, they shall be as white as snow." (Isaiah 1:18b) Our sins are washed away, perfectly atoned for by the precious blood of Christ. White is a symbol of purity and Jesus is the spotless Lamb of God; we believe that through Him His righteousness is imputed to every believer - so when the Father looks on us, He sees the pure, unfailing love and obedience of His only Son. Separated no more, we rejoice: "But now in Christ Jesus you who once were far off have been brought near by the blood of Christ." (Ephesians 2:13 ESV)

Scripture Passage and Sermon Outline

Proclamation of God's Word

Text: Deuteronomy 17:15-17, 1 Kings 4:26, 6:37-7:1 (ESV)

Title: Stewardship #2: The Dangers of Wealth

Teacher: Tim Rice

^{17:15} You may indeed set a king over you whom the LORD your God will choose. One from among your brothers you shall set as king over you. You may not put a foreigner over you, who is not your brother. ¹⁶ Only he must not acquire many horses for himself or cause the people to return to Egypt in order to acquire many horses, since the LORD has said to you, 'You shall never return that way again.' ¹⁷ And he shall not acquire many wives for himself, lest his heart turn away, nor shall he acquire for himself excessive silver and gold.

^{4:26} Solomon also had 40,000 stalls of horses for his chariots, and 12,000 horsemen...^{6:37} In the fourth year the foundation of the house of the LORD was laid, in the month of Ziv. ³⁸ And in the eleventh year, in the month of Bul, which is the eighth month, the house was finished in all its parts, and according to all its specifications. He was seven years in building it. ^{7:1} Solomon was building his own house thirteen years, and he finished his entire house.

Intro: Even as Solomon was wise, yet he was seduced by the power of wealth.

WARNINGS & FLAGRANT DENIAL

How can wealth and riches be seductive?

AND THEREFORE, GREATER WISDOM So what would it look like to live wisely – freed up from such bondage? YOU CAN PRAY WITH US... 1. Worship the LORD for His prioritizing people above all other created things. Praise Him, Father, Son and Holy Spirit for His love and for how He put His treasure where His heart is. 2. How have you lived intoxicated by earthly riches and blind to their power to drain you spiritually? Confess your pride and unbelief to Jesus, asking Him to forgive you and save you from their enslaving chains. 3. Thank Jesus for setting aside all of His heavenly privileges (power, wealth, beauty, attention) to come to our rescue. Give thanks to Him that "when you see him dying to make you his treasure, that can make him yours." 4. Who do you know that is enslaved by earthly riches? Pray for them, asking the Lord to make His love and surpassing worth known to them, and that He would help you to love them well vs. using them for access to their wealth. 5. Read 1 Timothy 6:6-11, 17-19. Ask the Holy Spirit to give you the ability to discern what is temporary vs. what is

eternal. Pray for the faith and courage to set your hope on Christ and eternity rather than what fades and disappoints.
