Call to Worship

We read God's Word, the Bible, together. It reveals to us who God is and what He expects of us.

2 Corinthians 4:5-7, 13-14 (ESV)

For what we proclaim is not ourselves, but Jesus Christ as Lord, with ourselves as your servants for Jesus' sake. For God, who said, "Let light shine out of darkness," has shone in our hearts to give the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ. But we have this treasure in jars of clay, to show that the surpassing power belongs to God and not to us. ... Since we have the same spirit of faith according to what has been written, "I believed, and so I spoke," we also believe, and so we also speak, knowing that he who raised the Lord Jesus will raise us also with Jesus and bring us with you into his presence.

Prayer of Adoration and Confession – Dan Anthony

We pray together praising God for who He really is (Adoration) and admitting our inability to live up to what He expects of us (Confession).

Assurance of Pardon

We again read God's Word together and are reminded that mercy and grace are freely given to all who have faith in Jesus Christ.

2 Corinthians 3:4-6 (ESV)

Such is the confidence that we have through Christ toward God. Not that we are sufficient in ourselves to claim anything as coming from us, but our sufficiency is from God, who has made us sufficient to be ministers of a new covenant, not of the letter but of the Spirit. For the letter kills, but the Spirit gives life.

Seasons of the Cross

White: "Though your sins are like scarlet, they shall be as white as snow." (Isaiah 1:18b) Our sins are washed away, perfectly atoned for by the precious blood of Christ. White is a symbol of purity, and Jesus is the spotless Lamb of God. We believe that through Him, His righteousness is imputed to every believer; so, when the Father looks on us, He sees the pure, unfailing love and obedience of His only Son. Separated no more, we rejoice: "But now in Christ Jesus you who once were far off have been brought near by the blood of Christ." (Eph 2:13)

Scripture Passage and Sermon Outline

Proclamation of God's Word

Text: Romans 10:8-17 (ESV)

Title: We Believe So We Speak

Teacher: Tim Rice

⁸ But what does it say? "The word is near you, in your mouth and in your heart" (that is, the word of faith that we proclaim); ⁹ because, if you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. ¹⁰ For with the heart one believes and is justified, and with the mouth one confesses and is saved. ¹¹ For the Scripture says, "Everyone who believes in him will not be put to shame." ¹² For there is no distinction between Jew and Greek; for the same Lord is Lord of all, bestowing his riches on all who call on him. ¹³ For "everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved." ¹⁴ How then will they call on him in whom they have not believed? And how are they to believe in him of whom they have never heard? And how are they to hear without someone preaching? ¹⁵ And how are they to preach unless they are sent? As it is written, "How beautiful are the feet of those who preach the good news!" ¹⁶ But they have not all obeyed the gospel. For Isaiah says, "Lord, who has believed what he has heard from us?" ¹⁷ So faith comes from hearing, and hearing through the word of Christ.

Can you recall when you were first embarrassed to be seen with your parents? What is that like when someone is ashamed of you?

THE MIRACLE OF ASSOCIATION

How is it a miracle that, in the Gospel, Jesus has gone on record with us?

YOU CAN PRAY WITH US...

1. Worship the LORD for His surpassing worth and holiness. Praise Him, Father, Son and Holy Spirit that He is so merciful and generous to enter into our shame, in Christ, in order to save us.
2. How have your words (or silence) been evidence of your unbelief in Christ's power and grace? Confess your empty-heartedness to Jesus and ask Him to forgive you and fill you instead with His love and power.
3. Give thanks to Jesus that He is true - in all that He says of us and in all that He says of Himself. Thank Him for His unrivaled trustworthiness and for His grace to save all who call on Him.
4. Who do you know that lives in shame because of their failings? Pray for them, asking the Lord to 1) help you truly love them with the love of Jesus, and 2) that He would open their eyes to hope in Christ.
5. Ask the Spirit to help you in communicating and living out His grace to your friends, neighbors and co-workers who do not yet know Christ. *Ask Him to work in you and in them producing the faith that we cannot produce.*
