# Call to Worship

We read God's Word, the Bible, together. It reveals to us who God is and what He expects of us. Psalm 19:1-11 (ESV)

The heavens declare the glory of God, and the sky above proclaims his handiwork. Day to day pours out speech, and night to night reveals knowledge. There is no speech, nor are there words, whose voice is not heard. Their voice goes out through all the earth, and their words to the end of the world. In them he has set a tent for the sun, which comes out like a bridegroom leaving his chamber, and, like a strong man, runs its course with joy. Its rising is from the end of the heavens, and its circuit to the end of them, and there is nothing hidden from its heat. The law of the LORD is perfect, reviving the soul; the testimony of the LORD is sure, making wise the simple; the precepts of the LORD are right, rejoicing the heart; the commandment of the LORD is pure, enlightening the eyes; the fear of the LORD is clean, enduring forever; the rules of the LORD are true, and righteous altogether. More to be desired are they than gold, even much fine gold; sweeter also than honey and drippings of the honeycomb. Moreover, by them is your servant warned; in keeping them there is great reward.

# Prayer of Adoration and Confession - John Tucker

#### Assurance of Pardon

#### Seasons of the Cross

Pentecost: Red, symbolizing the flame of the Holy Spirit, appearing first at Pentecost.

Acts 2:1-4a "When the day of Pentecost arrived, they were all together in one place. And suddenly there came from heaven a sound like a mighty rushing wind, and it filled the entire house where they were sitting. And divided tongues as of fire appeared to them and rested on each one of them. And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit..."

Imagine the striking, miraculous nature of this event to first century Jews - God dwelling IN human flesh to those who had only known life under the bondage of the old covenant. When He died, the veil in the temple separating the Holy of Holies was rent in two. And following His ascension, on this day of Pentecost, the very Spirit of God Himself descended upon man, to dwell INSIDE the hearts of every believer in Jesus. And that promise was not only for a small group of men and women in 1st century Jerusalem, but it extends to people like you and me, to everyone who believes in the precious name of Jesus. # Scripture Passage and Sermon Outline

#### Proclamation of God's Word

Text: Romans 9:2-5, 10:1-4, 18-21 & 11:1-2a, 5-6 (ESV)

Title: Sorrow Mixed with Hope Over Others' Unbelief

Teacher: Josh Floyd

9:2 I have great sorrow and unceasing anguish in my heart. <sup>3</sup> For I could wish that I myself were accursed and cut off from Christ for the sake of my brothers, my kinsmen according to the flesh. 4 They are Israelites, and to them belong the adoption, the glory, the covenants, the giving of the law, the worship, and the promises. <sup>5</sup> To them belong the patriarchs, and from their race, according to the flesh, is the Christ, who is God over all, blessed forever. Amen. ... 10:1 Brothers, my heart's desire and prayer to God for them is that they may be saved. <sup>2</sup> For I bear them witness that they have a zeal for God, but not according to knowledge. <sup>3</sup> For, being ignorant of the righteourness of God, and seeking to establish their own, they did not submit to God's righteourness. <sup>4</sup>For Christ is the end of the law for righteousness to everyone who believes. ... <sup>18</sup> But I ask, have they not heard? Indeed they have, for "Their voice has gone out to all the earth, and their words to the ends of the world." <sup>19</sup> But I ask, did Israel not understand? First Moses says, "I will make you jealous of those who are not a nation; with a foolish nation I will make you angry." <sup>20</sup> Then Isaiah is so bold as to say, "I have been found by those who did not seek me; I have shown myself to those who did not ask for me." 21 But of Israel he says, "All day long I have held out my hands to a disobedient and contrary people." ... 11:1 I ask, then, has God rejected his people? By no means! For I myself am an Israelite, a descendant of Abraham, a member of the tribe of Benjamin. <sup>2</sup> God has not rejected his people whom he foreknew. ... <sup>5</sup> So too at the present time there is a remnant, chosen by grace. <sup>6</sup> But if it is by grace, it is no longer on the basis of works; otherwise grace would no longer be grace.

#### PAUL'S RESPONSE TO UNBELIEF

GOD'S RESPONSE TO UNBELIEF
YOU CAN PRAY WITH US
1. Worship the LORD for His faithfulness, goodness and power! Praise Him Father, Son and Holy Spirit for His mercy and grace shown to people like you and me!
2. Confess to Jesus the ways in which you have not allowed yourself to be moved by or to experience sorrow over the "lostness" of your neighbors. Confess ways in which you have not believed that hope or salvation were even possible for certain people in your life.
3. Give thanks to God for Him rescuing us from the bondage of sin and death through the life, death and resurrection of Jesus. Thank Him that He is a God who pursues us and that He has been found by those who didn't seek him.
4. Who in your life thinks that they know Jesus but their life does not bear any fruit or resemble how a Christian should act in any way? Pray that the Lord would grab hold of their hearts and regenerate them. Pray for Godordained conversations to take place between the two of you.
5. Pray that the Holy Spirit would continue to give you eyes to see the "lostness" of those around you. And pray that you would be moved to sorrow mixed with hope and that you would have a willingness to enter into their story. Also, pray that the Holy Spirit would embolden you to push past fear and have gospel-centered conversations with your neighbors.
