Call to Worship

The Apostle's Creed:

He suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified dead and buried; He descended into hell. The third day He rose again from the dead. I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy catholic church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting. Amen.

Sacrament of the Lord's Supper

The ritual meal of Communion is a sign and seal of the grace we have in Jesus. That is, it symbolizes the work Christ did for our salvation (sign) and communicates the grace and mercy we have been given (seal) as a result of His death and resurrection.

Seasons of the Cross

The color green: A sign of life. In the plant kingdom, growth within an organism extends outward into tender green shoots, culminating in a blossom of life and a plant goes to seed, multiplying itself over and over again. On the cross, green is a symbol of the ongoing work of Christ in our hearts. Starting with the smallest seed, His work grows in us over our lifetime, shooting tendrils outward into the lives of others as His kingdom grows. Christ's work is ongoing, vibrant and alive in the hearts of His people.

Title: God's Comprehensive Ownership

Intro: In his work, *Revolutions*, what did Copernicus challenge?

OUR SOURCE, PATH & DESTINATION

What does it mean: *from Him, through Him and to Him is everything?*

A PRIDEFUL PRISON

How has God (*mercifully*) revealed how futile life is without Him?

OUR MERCIFUL AND NECESSARY REDEEMER

If God's nature is a mystery, one thing is not: *God causes, sustains and receives all things – therefore He is necessary!*

YOU CAN PRAY WITH US...

1. Worship the LORD for the mystery of His infinity and self-existence. Praise Him, Father, Son and Holy Spirit as the only true Source, Path and Destination for all things – for *absolutely everything!*
2. How have you lived as if God is not necessary at all? Confess your pride and rebellion to Jesus, asking Him to cleanse you by His death in your place and to change your heart by His Spirit.
3. Give thanks to Jesus for succeeding where we all have failed and for freely offering that success to us by faith. Thank Him for becoming poor in order to make us rich to the depths of His riches!
4. Who do you know that lives as if they source themselves, chart their own path, or as if Jesus is nowhere near their destination? Pray for them, asking the Lord to help them see how necessary the LORD is.
5. Read Romans 11:33-36 again. Ask the Holy Spirit to bear in you the fruit of faithfulness. Pray for insight into God's faithfulness and perfection, especially in His steadfastness to save His people.
