



Seasons of the Cross

The color green: A sign of life. In the plant kingdom, growth within an organism extends outward into tender green shoots, culminating in a blossom of life and a plant goes to seed, multiplying itself over and over again. On the cross, green is a symbol of the ongoing work of Christ in our hearts. Starting with the smallest seed, His work grows in us over our lifetime, shooting tendrils outward into the lives of others as His kingdom grows. Christ's work is ongoing, vibrant and alive in the hearts of His people.

Proclamation of God's Word

Text: Proverbs 4:1, 13 & 20-27 (ESV)

Title: Attentiveness Among Folly & Distraction

Teacher: Tim Rice

¹ Hear, O sons, a father's instruction, and be attentive, that you may gain insight, ... ¹³ Keep hold of instruction; do not let go; guard her, for she is your life. ... ²⁰ My son, be attentive to my words; incline your ear to my sayings. ²¹ Let them not escape from your sight; keep them within your heart. ²² For they are life to those who find them, and healing to all their flesh. ²³ Keep your heart with all vigilance, for from it flow the springs of life. ²⁴ Put away from you crooked speech, and put devious talk far from you. ²⁵ Let your eyes look directly forward, and your gaze be straight before you. ²⁶ Ponder the path of your feet; then all your ways will be sure. ²⁷ Do not swerve to the right or to the left; turn your foot away from evil.

DISTRACTED & FOOLISH

SAVED & RE-FOCUSED

How has Jesus worked to rescue us from our departures from God (guilt) and to recover us to be faithful and focused?

YOU CAN PRAY WITH US ...

1. Worship the LORD that He sees, that He is attentive and perfectly knowledgeable of all things and all people (including you). Praise Him, Father, Son and Holy Spirit, that He attends to you.
2. How have you lived without focus upon the Lord and overcome by distractions? Confess your lack of discipline and attention to Jesus, asking Him to forgive you *and to capture your heart with His gaze upon you.*
3. Give thanks to Jesus for His dazzling work to save distracted people like us. Thank Him for perfectly attending to the Father (*as we should have*), giving us His record, all while He perfectly attended to you in your sin.
4. Who do you know that lives in an undisciplined or unfocused way? Pray for them, asking the LORD to help them, and to give you wisdom in how to engage them for Christ.
5. Ask the Holy Spirit to bear in you the fruit of faithfulness and self control. Pray that He would help you to grow in your attentiveness to the LORD and to defend you against distractions.
