### Call to Worship

We read God's Word, the Bible, together. It reveals to us who God is and what He expects of us.

Psalm 29 (ESV)

Ascribe to the LORD, O heavenly beings, ascribe to the LORD glory and strength. Ascribe to the LORD the glory due his name; worship the LORD in the splendor of holiness. The voice of the LORD is over the waters; the God of glory thunders, the LORD, over many waters. The voice of the LORD is powerful; the voice of the LORD is full of majesty. ### Assurance of Pardon

We again read God's Word together and are reminded that mercy and grace are freely given to all who have faith in Jesus Christ. Galatians 3:10-14 (ESV)

For all who rely on works of the law are under a curse; for it is written, "Cursed be everyone who does not abide by all things written in the Book of the Law, and do them." Now it is evident that no one is justified before God by the law, for "The righteous shall live by faith." But the law is not of faith, rather "The one who does them shall live by them." Christ redeemed us from the curse of the law by becoming a curse for us—for it is written, "Cursed is everyone who is hanged on a tree"— so that in Christ Jesus the blessing of Abraham might come to the Gentiles, so that we might receive the promised Spirit through faith.

### Seasons of the Cross

The color green: a sign of life. In the plant kingdom, growth within an organism extends outward into tender green shoots, culminating in a blossom of life and as a plant goes to seed, multiplying itself over and over again. On the cross, green is a symbol of the ongoing work of Christ in our hearts. Starting with the smallest seed, His work grows in us over our lifetime, shooting tendrils outward into the lives of others as His kingdom grows. Christ's work is ongoing, vibrant and alive in the hearts of His people.

### Scripture Passage and Sermon Outline

### Proclamation of God's Word

Text: Genesis 12:1-9 (ESV)
Title: Called By God
Teacher: Stan McMahan

<sup>1</sup> Now the LORD said to Abram, "Go from your country and your kindred and your father's house to the land that I will show you. <sup>2</sup> And I will make of you a great nation, and I will bless you and make your name great, so that you will be a blessing. <sup>3</sup> I will bless those who bless you, and him who dishonors you I will curse, and in you all the families of the earth shall be blessed."

<sup>4</sup> So Abram went, as the LORD had told him, and Lot went with him. Abram was seventy-five years old when he departed from Haran. <sup>5</sup> And Abram took Sarai his wife, and Lot his brother's son, and all their possessions that they had gathered, and the people that they had acquired in Haran, and they set out to go to the land of Canaan. When they came to the land of Canaan, <sup>6</sup> Abram passed through the land to the place at Shechem, to the oak of Moreh. At that time the Canaanites were in the land. <sup>7</sup> Then the LORD appeared to Abram and said, "To your offspring I will give this land." So he built there an altar to the LORD, who had appeared to him. <sup>8</sup> From there he moved to the hill country on the east of Bethel and pitched his tent, with Bethel on the west and Ai on the east. And there he built an altar to the LORD and called upon the name of the LORD. <sup>9</sup> And Abram journeyed on, still going toward the Negeb.

Intro: What makes a call important or unimportant?

### From Your Country

Why does God call us to leave the way of life that comes most naturally to us? How are we (like Abram) steeped in a culture that ignores God and tries to replace Him?

# To The Land I Will Show You Why does God call Abram to move with general directions but no details? What is the ultimate blessing that God is calling Abram (and us) to receive?

For what purpose does God say He is blessing Abram? Why does receiving God's blessing always lead to this kind of life?

### YOU CAN PRAY WITH US...

So That You Will Be A Blessing

- 1. Worship God, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, for His glory and strength. Praise Him for the power of His voice to call things that do not exist into existence!
- 2. How have you lived ignoring God's calling (as if what He says doesn't matter) and trying to replace Him with created things? Ask God to forgive you and give you new life in Christ Jesus.
- 3. Give thanks to Jesus for His work to fulfill the promises made to Abraham. Praise Him that through His life, death, and resurrection forgiveness and new life are given to all who believe.
- 4. Who do you know that avoids God's call in Scripture? Ask God to open their eyes to see the truth and goodness of God's offer of a personal relationship with Him through Jesus.
- 5. Ask the Holy Spirit to grow in you the freedom to live for the good of others. Pray that He would set your heart free from selfishness by helping you rejoice in the work of Christ for you (Gal. 3:13-14).
