The color green: A sign of life. Proclamation of God's Word

Text: Proverbs 11:17, 21:21 & 28:12-14 (ESV)

Title: The Wisdom To Be Kind

Teacher: Tim Rice

^{11:17} A man who is kind benefits himself, but a cruel man hurts himself. ... ^{21:21} Whoever pursues righteousness and kindness will find life, righteousness, and honor. ... ^{28:12} When the righteous triumph, there is great glory, but when the wicked rise, people hide themselves. ¹³ Whoever conceals his transgressions will not prosper, but he who confesses and forsakes them will obtain mercy. ¹⁴ Blessed is the one who fears the LORD always, but whoever hardens his heart will fall into calamity.

Intro: What comes to your mind when you hear the word "kind"?

CONSIDER THE ALTERNATIVE

How does twisting God's design render us cruel and hard-hearted?

- 1. Worship the LORD for His kindness. Praise Him, Father, Son and Holy Spirit, for how His loving kindness endures forever, especially in light of what we deserve in our sin.
- 2. How have you lived with unkind ways or with a hard disposition? Confess your hard-heartedness to Jesus, asking Him to forgive you and (by His Spirit) to change your heart into His likeness.
- 3. Give thanks to Jesus for His ultimate kindness to do such ultimate good to you and to do it so freely. Thank Him for dying in your place, without hesitation, and for giving His righteousness to you without regret.
- 4. Who do you know that is hard-hearted or unkind? Pray for them, asking the Lord to help them to see their spiritual peril and that He would have mercy on them as He has had upon you.
- 5. Ask the Holy Spirit to bear in you the fruit of love and kindness. Read Titus 3:3-7 and pray for such a grasp of His mercy and kindness to you in Christ that your heart would overflow with kindness toward others.
