Confession of Faith

I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy catholic church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting. Amen.

Sacrament of the Lord's Supper

The ritual meal of Communion is a sign and seal of the grace we have in Jesus. That is, it symbolizes the work Christ did for our salvation (sign) and communicates the grace and mercy we have been given (seal) as a result of His death and resurrection.

Seasons of the Cross

The color green: a sign of life. Starting with the smallest seed, His work grows in us over our lifetime, shooting tendrils outward into the lives of others as His kingdom grows. Scripture Passage and Sermon Outline

Proclamation of God's Word

Text: Genesis 22:1-18 (ESV)

Title: God's Mission & Method

Teacher: Tim Rice

¹ After these things God tested Abraham and said to him, "Abraham!" And he said, "Here I am." ² He said, "Take your son, your only son Isaac, whom you love, and go to the land of Moriah, and offer him there as a burnt offering on one of the mountains of which I shall tell you." ³ So Abraham rose early in the morning, saddled his donkey, and took two of his young men with him, and his son Isaac. And he cut the wood for the burnt offering and arose and went to the place of which God had told him. ⁴ On the third day Abraham lifted up his eyes and saw the place from afar. ⁵ Then Abraham said to his young men, "Stay here with the donkey; I and the boy will go over there and worship and come again to you." ⁶ And Abraham took the wood of the burnt offering and laid it on Isaac his son. And he took in his hand the fire and the knife. So they went both of them together. ⁷ And Isaac said to his father Abraham, "My father!" And he said, "Here I am, my son." He said, "Behold, the fire and the wood, but where is the lamb for a burnt offering?" ⁸ Abraham said, "God will provide for himself the lamb for a burnt offering, my son." So they went both of them together.

⁹ When they came to the place of which God had told him, Abraham built the altar there and laid the wood in order and bound Isaac his son and laid him on the altar, on top of the wood. ¹⁰ Then Abraham reached out his hand and took the knife to slaughter his son. ¹¹ But the angel of the LORD called to him from heaven and said, "Abraham, Abraham!" And he said, "Here I am." ¹² He said, "Do not lay your hand on the boy or do anything to him, for now I know that you fear God, seeing you have not withheld your son, your only son, from me." ¹³ And Abraham lifted up his eyes and looked, and behold, behind him was a ram, caught in a thicket by his horns. And Abraham went and took the ram and offered it up as a burnt offering instead of his son. ¹⁴ So Abraham called the name of that place, "The LORD will provide"; as it is said to this day, "On the mount of the LORD it shall be provided."

¹⁵ And the angel of the LORD called to Abraham a second time from heaven ¹⁶ and said, "By myself I have sworn, declares the LORD, because you have done this and have not withheld your son, your only son, ¹⁷ I will surely bless you, and I will surely multiply your offspring as the stars of heaven and as the sand that is on the seashore. And your offspring shall possess the gate of his enemies, ¹⁸ and in your offspring shall all the nations of the earth be blessed, because you have obeyed my voice."

Intro: How sure are you that you really trust a pilot (watch or fly)?

THE PLACE OF GOD'S WORKING

Why can you trust God to work out all things, even over a very long time?

THE CRITICAL MOMENT

How does God's call always lead us to a critical moment, an hour of judgment?

THE METHOD

How does God consistently work by death and resurrection?

YOU CAN PRAY WITH US...

1. *Worship the LORD for His good Ownership.* Praise Him, Father, Son and Holy Spirit for how He is worthy of our trust, both by His power over death and for how He provides so generously.
2. How have you lived as if God's rule is a threat rather than a blessing? Confess your pride to Jesus, asking Him to forgive you for trying to add Him to your agenda rather than submit and trust Him for His good rule.
3. Give thanks to Jesus for bearing the costs of someone as rebellious as you are. Thank Him for being the Substitute you need - taking your execution and securing your future by His love and power.
4. Who do you know that worships God's gifts more than they worship the LORD as the Giver of all good things? Pray for them, asking God to have mercy on them as He has had on you.
5. Ask the Holy Spirit to grow you in your confidence in the Father's provision and trustworthiness, *especially that He can work even through sacrifice for your good.* Pray for the Spirit's fruit of joy and peace.
