SONG OF GATHERING & PREPARATION

The Blessing

CALL TO WORSHIP | Psalm 96:7-9 (ESV)

We read God's Word, the Bible, together. It reveals to us who God is and what He expects of us.

Ascribe to the LORD, O families of the peoples, ascribe to the LORD glory and strength! Ascribe to the LORD the glory due his name; bring an offering, and come into his courts! Worship the LORD in the splendor of holiness; tremble before him, all the earth!

PRAYER OF ADORATION & CONFESSION

We pray together praising God for who He really is (Adoration) and admitting our inability to live up to what He expects of us (Confession).

ASSURANCE OF PARDON | Ephesians 2:17-22 (ESV)

We read God's Word together and are reminded that mercy and grace are freely given to all who have faith in Jesus Christ.

And he came and preached peace to you who were far off and peace to those who were near. For through him we both have access in one Spirit to the Father. So then you are no longer strangers and aliens, but you are fellow citizens with the saints and members of the household of God, built on the foundation of the apostles and prophets, Christ Jesus himself being the cornerstone, in whom the whole structure, being joined together, grows into a holy temple in the Lord. In him you also are being built together into a dwelling place for God by the Spirit.

Proclamation of God's Word

Text: Hebrews 13:1-7, 15-16 (ESV) Title: Family Values of God's People: Living in Philadelphia Teacher: Tim Rice

¹ Let brotherly love continue. ² Do not neglect to show hospitality to strangers, for thereby some have entertained angels unawares. ³ Remember those who are in prison, as though in prison with them, and those who are mistreated, since you also are in the body. ⁴ Let marriage be held in honor among all, and let the marriage bed be undefiled, for God will judge the sexually immoral and adulterous. ⁵ Keep your life free from love of money, and be content with what you have, for he has said, "I will never leave you nor forsake you." ⁶ So we can confidently say, "The Lord is my helper; I will not fear; what can man do to me?" ⁷ Remember your leaders, those who spoke to you the word of God. Consider the outcome of their way of life, and imitate their faith. ... ¹⁵ Through him then let us continually offer up a sacrifice of praise to God, that is, the fruit of lips that acknowledge his name. ¹⁶ Do not neglect to do good and to share what you have, for such sacrifices are pleasing to God.

- 3. Give thanks to Jesus for the wonders of His saving love, especially to know our true sinful state and claim us anyway! Thank Him for hearing and seeing you in your bondage and distress *and claiming you as His*!
- 4. Who do you know that is in trouble or distress, especially if they claim to be a follower of Jesus? Pray for them, asking the Lord to help them, and to use you as He can to encourage them and meet their needs.
- 5. Ask the Holy Spirit to bear in you His fruit of love, kindness and goodness, especially for others around you who need care. Pray for His eyes to see and ears to hear, so that as the LORD saw and heard your distress, that you will see and hear others.
