SONG OF GATHERING & PREPARATION

The people of God always sang as they ascended the hill in Jerusalem up to the temple to worship (see Psalms 120-134). We, as well, prepare our hearts, minds, and bodies for worship by singing about the God we serve.

Power To Redeem

CALL TO WORSHIP | John 1:1-5, 11-14 (ESV)

We read God's Word, the Bible, together. It reveals to us who God is and what He expects of us.

In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. He was in the beginning with God. All things were made through him, and without him was not any thing made that was made. In him was life, and the life was the light of men. The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness has not overcome it. ... He came to his own, and his own people did not receive him. But to all who did receive him, who believed in his name, he gave the right to become children of God, who were born, not of blood nor of the will of the flesh nor of the will of man, but of God. And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we have seen his glory, glory as of the only Son from the Father, full of grace and truth.

PRAYER OF ADORATION & CONFESSION

We pray together praising God for who He really is (Adoration) and admitting our inability to live up to what He expects of us (Confession).

ASSURANCE OF PARDON | Isaiah 53:4-6 (ESV)

We read God's Word together and are reminded that mercy and grace are freely given to all who have faith in Jesus Christ.

Surely he has borne our griefs and carried our sorrows; yet we esteemed him stricken, smitten by God, and afflicted. 5 But he was pierced for our transgressions; he was crushed for our iniquities; upon him was the chastisement that brought us peace, and with his wounds we are healed. 6 All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned—every one—to his own way; and the LORD has laid on him the iniquity of us all.

SCRIPTURE PASSAGE & SERMON OUTLINE

Proclamation of God's Word

Text: Hebrews 11:1-3; Genesis 1:1-3 & 2:7 (ESV) Title: By Faith: Creation Teacher: Tim Rice

Hebrews 11:1 Now faith is the assurance of things hoped for, the conviction of things not seen. ² For by it the people of old received their commendation. ³ By faith we understand that the universe was created by the word of God, so that what is seen was not made out of things that are visible. ... ^{Genesis 1:1} In the beginning, God created the heavens and the earth. ² The earth was without form and void, and darkness was over the face of the deep. And the Spirit of God was hovering over the face of the waters. ³ And God said, "Let there be light," and there was light. ... ^{2:7} then the LORD God formed the man of dust from the ground and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life, and the man became a living creature.

Intro: How deeply do you believe in God's work of creation?

WHAT CAN YOU SEE?

How has God's creation revealed His power, goodness and authority?

WHAT HAVE WE DONE?

How have we utterly defied God's work as our Creator?

WHAT HAS HE DONE?

What do we believe that Jesus has done as our Maker and Savior?

YOU CAN PRAY WITH US ...

- 1. Worship the LORD, God Almighty as your Maker! Praise Him, Father, Son and Holy Spirit for His goodness and grace to give you life.
- 2. How have you lived as if you are your own, rather than being His by His work of creation? Confess your pride and unbelief to Jesus, asking Him to forgive you and restore you to His good design.
- 3. Give thanks to Jesus for His willingness to surrender His breath and be buried in dust to save us. Thank Him for *bearing the curse of our rebellion* and offering to us *the commendation of His love and faithfulness*.
- 4. Who do you know that doubts God's power, goodness and authority? Pray for them, asking the Lord to help them to see the folly of their unbelief and turn back to Him as their God and Savior.
- 5. Ask the Spirit to bear in you His fruit of love and goodness. Pray for His work to restore you, empower you and give you direction to live in line with His good design.
