EXPLANATION OF ADVENT THEME: PROMISE | John Tucker

CALL TO WORSHIP/LIGHTING OF ADVENT CANDLE | The Yan Family - John 1:1-5, 9-14 (ESV)

We read God's Word, the Bible, together. It reveals to us who God is and what He expects of us.

In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. He was in the beginning with God. All things were made through him, and without him was not any thing made that was made. In him was life, and the life was the light of men. The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness has not overcome it. ... The true light, which gives light to everyone, was coming into the world. He was in the world, and the world was made through him, yet the world did not know him. He came to his own, and his own people did not receive him. But to all who did receive him, who believed in his name, he gave the right to become children of God, who were born, not of blood nor of the will of the flesh nor of the will of man, but of God. And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we have seen his glory, glory as of the only Son from the Father, full of grace and truth.

PRAYER OF ADORATION & CONFESSION | John Tucker

We pray together praising God for who He really is (Adoration) and admitting our inability to live up to what He expects of us (Confession).

ASSURANCE OF PARDON | John 3:16-21 (ESV)

We read God's Word together and are reminded that mercy and grace are freely given to all who have faith in Jesus Christ.

"For God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life. For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but in order that the world might be saved through him. Whoever believes in him is not condemned, but whoever does not believe is condemned already, because he has not believed in the name of the only Son of God. And this is the judgment: the light has come into the world, and people loved the darkness rather than the light because their works were evil. For everyone who does wicked things hates the light and does not come to the light, lest his works should be exposed. But whoever does what is true comes to the light, so that it may be clearly seen that his works have been carried out in God."

SCRIPTURE PASSAGE & SERMON OUTLINE

Proclamation of God's Word

Text: John 8:12-20 (ESV) Title: I AM the Light of the World Teacher: Brown Peterson

¹² Again Jesus spoke to them, saying, "I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will not walk in darkness, but will have the light of life." ¹³ So the Pharisees said to him, "You are bearing witness about yourself; your testimony is not true." ¹⁴ Jesus answered, "Even if I do bear witness about myself, my testimony is true, for I know where I came from and where I am going, but you do not know where I come from or where I am going. ¹⁵ You judge according to the flesh; I judge no one. ¹⁶ Yet even if I do judge, my judgment is true, for it is not I alone who judge, but I and the Father who sent me. ¹⁷ In your Law it is written that the testimony of two people is true. ¹⁸ I am the one who bears witness about myself, and the Father who sent me bears witness about me." ¹⁹ They said to him therefore, "Where is your Father?" Jesus answered, "You know neither me nor my Father. If you knew me, you would know my Father also." ²⁰ These words he spoke in the treasury, as he taught in the temple; but no one arrested him, because his hour had not yet come.

THE WALK

YOU CAN PRAY WITH US ...

- 1. Worship the LORD, who is the true and pure light– that He loves with a purpose toward us to bring us out of darkness to His glorious presence. Praise Him, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, that He is steadfast in His commitment to us.
- 2. Where do you live in the dark? What darkness do you love? Where do you need to be exposed so that you can repent and be free? Confess the darkness that is in you, the darkness that you love, and ask for exposure and freedom in the light.
- 3. Give thanks to Jesus that He is the Light of the World. That He came to dwell in the dark world to bring us, who were lost, to Himself, so that we may have the light of life. Who do you know that is unaware that the world is dark?
- 4. Who do you know that needs this light of Jesus in their life? Pray for courage and boldness to talk about the greatest news you have with them.
- Ask the Holy Spirit to keep changing your desires to love that light. Ask Him to abide closely, to keep you following the Light of the World, and that your light would draw others to you so that you can talk about Jesus.
