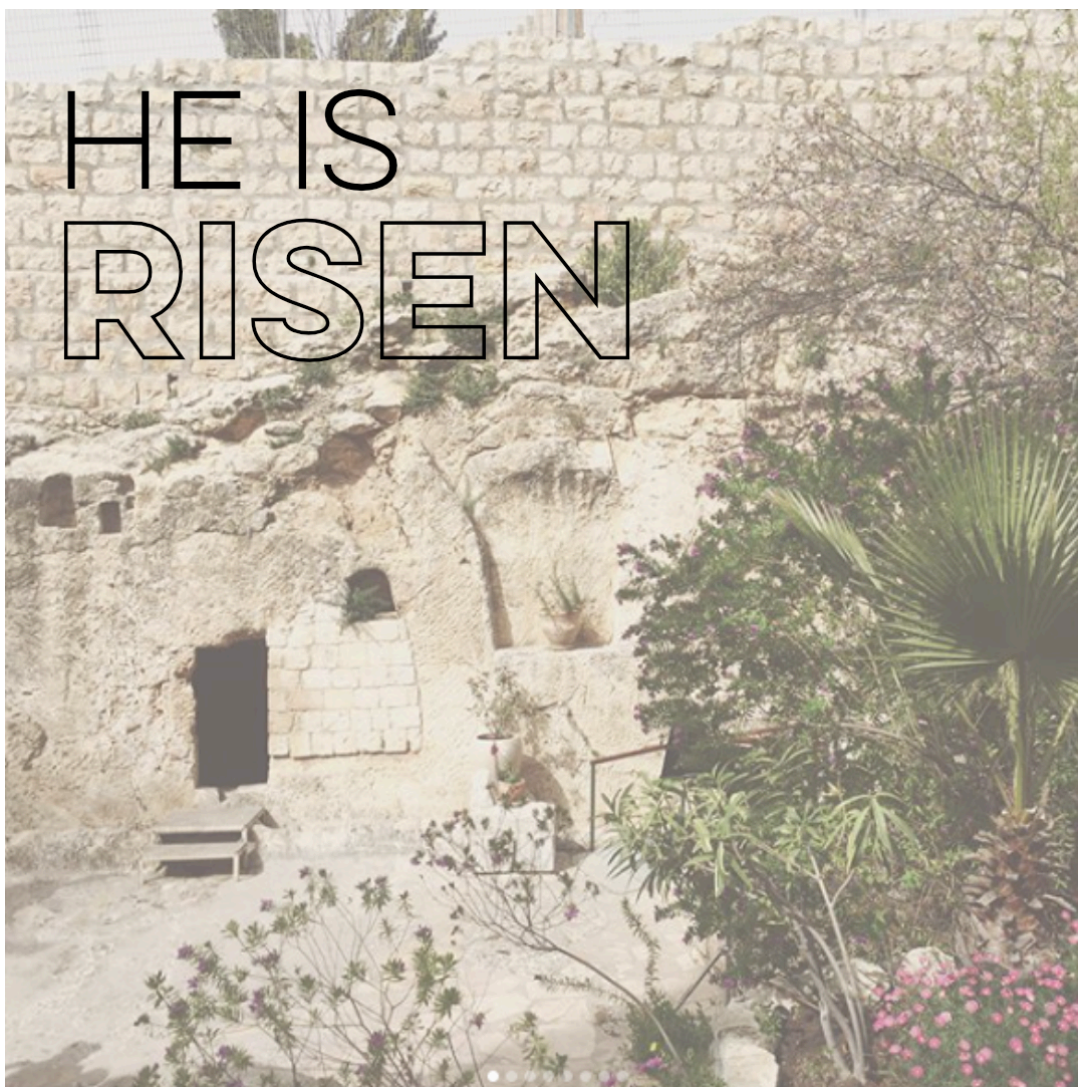

## **Seasons of the Cross**

Purple for Easter: In the ancient world, purple was the color of royalty, worn only by kings and highest officials in the royal court. It was a costly pigment to make, and therefore very rare. The color of kingship. "Therefore Pilate said to Him, "So You are a king?" Jesus answered, "You say correctly that I am a king. For this I have been born, and for this I have come into the world, to testify to the truth. Everyone who is of the truth hears My voice." JOHN 18:37. This King Jesus did what no one, not even His own disciples expected. After three days, after taking on the sins of every believer ever born (past, present, future) He wrestled and defeated sin once and for all, and rose from the dead. No one has ever been or will ever be like Him. The incomparable, matchless King. And He will return again. "And on His robe and on His thigh He has a name written, "KING OF KINGS, AND LORD OF LORDS." ## Scripture Passage and Sermon Outline

### Proclamation of God's Word

**Text:** Romans 8:28, 31-39 (ESV)

**Title:** Secure & Hopeful In God's Love

**Teacher:** Tim Rice

*28 And we know that for those who love God all things work together for good, for those who are called according to His purpose. ... 31 What then shall we say to these things? If God is for us, who can be against us? 32 He who did not spare His own Son but gave Him up for us all, how will He not also with Him graciously give us all things? 33 Who shall bring any charge against God's elect? It is God who justifies. 34 Who is to condemn? Christ Jesus is the one who died—more than that, who was raised—who is at the right hand of God, who indeed is interceding for us. 35 Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? Shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or danger, or sword? 36 As it is written, “For your sake we are being killed all the day long; we are regarded as sheep to be slaughtered.” 37 No, in all these things we are more than conquerors through Him who loved us. 38 For I am sure that neither death nor life, nor angels nor rulers, nor things present nor things to come, nor powers, 39 nor height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God in Christ Jesus our Lord.*

*Work together* doesn't mean prevent. And *anything* doesn't mean riches, ease, comfort or self indulgence.

Why do we believe that God can work all things together for our good?

## YOU CAN PRAY WITH US...

1. Worship the LORD, God Almighty for His wisdom and power over suffering and death. Praise Him, Father, Son and Holy Spirit for His sovereign ability to turn everything bad to ultimate, eternal good.
2. How have you lived as if what you fear is more powerful than Jesus and His love for you? Confess the unbelief that lies beneath your fears to Jesus, *asking Him to forgive you and to secure you by His sovereign power.*
3. Give thanks to Jesus for the 2 phases of His work. Thank Him for His conquest of sin, death and hell by His death and resurrection, and thank Him for His eventual resolution of all that is wrong at His return.
4. Who do you know that lives hopelessly, controlled by their fears? Pray for them, asking the Lord to conquer their fears by His death (to cleanse them from guilt) and His resurrection (to save them from death).
5. Ask the Holy Spirit to give you insight and wisdom in the face of suffering and death. Pray that He would anchor you in Jesus' sovereign power and love vs. all that is wrong in you and broken in this world.
