SCRIPTURE PASSAGE & SERMON OUTLINE

Proclamation of God's Word

Text: Hebrews 11:27-28; Exodus 12:1-3, 5, 12-13, 21-23, 28-31 (ESV) Title: By Faith: Moses - Part 2 Teacher: Tim Rice

Hebrews 11:27 By faith he left Egypt, not being afraid of the anger of the king, for he endured as seeing him who is invisible. ²⁸ By faith he kept the Passover and sprinkled the blood, so that the Destroyer of the firstborn might not touch them. ... Exodus 12:1 The LORD said to Moses and Aaron in the land of Egypt, ² "This month shall be for you the beginning of months. It shall be the first month of the year for you. ³ Tell all the congregation of Israel that on the tenth day of this month every man shall take a lamb according to their fathers' houses, a lamb for a household. ... ⁵ Your lamb shall be without blemish, a male a year old. You may take it from the sheep or from the goats, ... ¹² or I will pass through the land of Egypt that night, and I will strike all the firstborn in the land of Egypt, both man and beast; and on all the gods of Egypt I will execute judgments: I am the LORD. ¹³ The blood shall be a sign for you, on the houses where you are. And when I see the blood, I will pass over you, and no plague will befall you to destroy you, when I strike the land of Egypt." ... ²¹ Then Moses called all the elders of Israel and said to them, "Go and select lambs for yourselves according to your clans, and kill the Passover lamb. ²² Take a bunch of hyssop and dip it in the blood that is in the basin, and touch the lintel and the two doorposts with the blood that is in the basin. None of you shall go out of the door of his house until the morning. ²³ For the LORD will pass through to strike the Egyptians, and when he sees the blood on the lintel and on the two doorposts, the LORD will pass over the door and will not allow the destroyer to enter your houses to strike you." ... ²⁸ Then the people of Israel went and did so; as the LORD had commanded Moses and Aaron, so they did. ²⁹ At midnight the LORD struck down all the firstborn in the land of Egypt, from the firstborn of Pharaoh who sat on his throne to the firstborn of the captive who was in the dungeon, and all the firstborn of the livestock. ³⁰ And Pharaoh rose up in the night, he and all his servants and all the Egyptians. And there was a great cry in Egypt, for there was not a house where someone was not dead. ³¹ Then he summoned Moses and Aaron by night and said, "Up, go out from among my people, both you and the people of Israel; and go, serve the LORD, as you have said.

Intro: All we do is shaped by some future hope. What is yours?

ULTIMATE CONFLICT

Why do we believe the threat of judgment is just and universal?

TRUE FORGIVENESS

How is God's gift of atonement humbling even as it is comforting?

PRESENT HOPE How does God's power and grace lead us to live in faith?

YOU CAN PRAY WITH US ...

- 1. Worship the LORD for His grace and mercy in the midst of His justice. Praise Him, Father, Son and Holy Spirit, that He is willing to provide a way of redemption then.
- 2. How have you lived as if God will do nothing more in the future? Confess your pride and unbelief to Jesus, asking Him to forgive you and to change your heart to cherish Him as you should.
- 3. Give thanks to Jesus for His work to strike the gods (and darkness) of this world to redeem His people. Thank Him for *delivering you* from the dominion of evil and *translating you into His kingdom of love and forgiveness*.
- 4. Who do you know that lives with no real defense against evil? Pray for them, asking the Lord to make Himself known to them and to set them free in Christ.
- 5. Ask the Holy Spirit to bear in you His fruit of love and joy, especially because of the hope given to us in Jesus. Pray for a greater confidence in all that Jesus has promised because of all that He has already done.
