SONG OF GATHERING & PREPARATION

CALL TO WORSHIP | Romans 11:33-36, 12:2a (ESV)

We read God's Word, the Bible, together. It reveals to us who God is and what He expects of us.

Oh, the depth of the riches and wisdom and knowledge of God! How unsearchable are his judgments and how inscrutable his ways! "For who has known the mind of the Lord, or who has been his counselor?" "Or who has given a gift to him that he might be repaid?" For from him and through him and to him are all things. To him be glory forever. Amen. ... Do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewal of your mind.

PRAYER OF ADORATION & CONFESSION

We read God's Word together and are reminded that mercy and grace are freely given to all who have faith in Jesus Christ.

CONFESSION OF FAITH

From the New City Catechism:

- Q. 17. What is idolatry?

- Q. 18. Will God allow our disobedience and idolatry to go unpunished?
- A. No, every sin is against the sovereignty, holiness, and goodness of God, and against his righteous law, and God is righteously angry with our sins and will punish them in his just judgment both in this life, and in the life to come.

SCRIPTURE PASSAGE & SERMON OUTLINE

Proclamation of God's Word

Text: Psalm 16 (ESV)

Title: Apart From You There Is No Good

Teacher: Tim Rice

16 Preserve me, O God, for in you I take refuge. 2 I say to the LORD, "You are my Lord; I have no good apart from you." 3 As for the saints in the land, they are the excellent ones, in whom is all my delight. 4 The sorrows of those who run after another god shall multiply; their drink offerings of blood I will not pour out or take their names on my lips. 5 The LORD is my chosen portion and my cup; you hold my lot. 6 The lines have fallen for me in pleasant places; indeed, I have a beautiful inheritance. 7 I bless the LORD who gives me counsel; in the night also my heart instructs me. 8 I have set the LORD always before me; because he is at my right hand, I shall not be shaken. 9 Therefore my heart is glad, and my whole being rejoices; my flesh also dwells secure. 10 For you will not abandon my soul to Sheol, or let your holy one see corruption. 11 You make known to me the path of life; in your presence there is fullness of joy; at your right hand are pleasures forevermore.

INTRO: When have you felt most needy? And why?

FROM DEEPEST NEEDS

What is it like to have a sense of need, and then see it met?

TO NEEDLESS What is life like with an alternative origin or destiny?

TO GRACIOUS, ENDLESS TREASURE

But what if you were immeasurably rich?

YOU CAN PRAY WITH US ...

- 1. Worship the LORD for His sheer necessity and for His richness. Praise and adore Him for being so kind as to show you just how much you need Him, and for being so lavish in meeting your needs!
- 2. How have you ignored God, and behaved as if you can functionally live without Him? Confess your presumption to Jesus, asking Him to forgive you and convince you of His sufficiency.
- 3. Give thanks to Jesus for succeeding where Adam (and we have) failed. Thank Him for bearing our multiple sorrows, pouring out His own blood as an atoning sacrifice, and taking even our name upon His lips to save us.
- 4. Who do you know who lives (or attempts to live) apart from the Lord? Pray for them, asking Jesus to have mercy on them and to reveal to them just how greatly they need Him, and also how present and generous He is.
- 5. Ask the Holy Spirit to persuade you that God does not just *give* you "your portion and cup" but that He *is* "your portion and cup." Ask Him to enlarge your understanding of just how truly rich you are in Christ!
