#### CALL TO WORSHIP | 2 Corinthians 3:17-18a (ESV)

We read God's Word, the Bible, together. It reveals to us who God is and what He expects of us.

Now the Lord is the Spirit, and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is freedom. And we all, with unveiled face, beholding the glory of the Lord, are being transformed into the same image from one degree of glory to another.

#### **PRAYER OF ADORATION & CONFESSION**

#### ASSURANCE OF PARDON | Ezekiel 36:24-27, 28b (ESV)

We read God's Word together and are reminded that mercy and grace are freely given to all who have faith in Jesus Christ.

I will take you from the nations and gather you from all the countries and bring you into your own land. I will sprinkle clean water on you, and you shall be clean from all your uncleannesses, and from all your idols I will cleanse you. And I will give you a new heart, and a new spirit I will put within you. And I will remove the heart of stone from your flesh and give you a heart of flesh. And I will put my Spirit within you, and cause you to walk in my statutes and be careful to obey my rules. ... You shall be my people, and I will be your God.

# SCRIPTURE PASSAGE & SERMON OUTLINE

**Proclamation of God's Word** 

Text: Psalm 27 (ESV) Title: One Thing I Will Seek Teacher: Tim Rice

1 The LORD is my light and my salvation; whom shall I fear? The LORD is the stronghold of my life; of whom shall I be afraid? 2 When evildoers assail me to eat up my flesh, my adversaries and foes, it is they who stumble and fall. 3 Though an army encamp against me, my heart shall not fear; though war arise against me, yet I will be confident. 4 One thing have I asked of the LORD, that will I seek after: that I may dwell in the house of the LORD all the days of my life, to gaze upon the beauty of the LORD and to inquire in his temple. 5 For he will hide me in his shelter in the day of trouble; he will conceal me under the cover of his tent; he will lift me high upon a rock. 6 And now my head shall be lifted up above my enemies all around me, and I will offer in his tent sacrifices with shouts of joy; I will sing and make melody to the LORD. 7 Hear, O LORD, when I cry aloud; be gracious to me and answer me! 8 You have said, "Seek my face." My heart says to you, "Your face, LORD, do I seek." 9 Hide not your face from me. Turn not your servant away in anger, O you who have been my help. Cast me not off; forsake me not, O God of my salvation! 10 For my father and my mother have forsaken me, but the LORD will take me in. 11 Teach me your way, O LORD, and lead me on a level path because of my enemies. 12 Give me not up to the will of my adversaries; for false witnesses have risen against me, and they breathe out violence. 13 I believe that I shall look upon the goodness of the LORD in the land of the living! 14 Wait for the LORD; be strong, and let your heart take courage; wait for the LORD!

# YOU CAN PRAY WITH US ...

- 1. Worship the LORD for how He is glorious in His beauty, power and love. Praise Him, Father, Son and Holy Spirit, for how He has made Himself known to us *so that we can have the highest and best joys possible in Him*.
- 2. How have you lived as if you have to follow through on your desires *in order to be authentic?* Confess your pride and unbelief to Jesus, asking Him to forgive your idolatries and fulfill you by His sufficiency.
- 3. Give thanks to Jesus for how He was *rejected in our place that we would gain His worth. Thank Him for being* passionately committed to every *good* desire, the love of His Father's surpassing worth, to give us His new desires.
- 4. Who do you know who lives controlled (enslaved?) by their desires? Pray for them, asking the Lord to make known to them His saving power and love and that He would set them free.
- 5. Ask the Holy Spirit to bear in you His fruit of love and peace, especially in how *the LORD alone is sufficient to anchor your worth and life passions*. Pray for His work to root out your idols, and to establish you in Christ.
