Seasons of the Cross

White: "though your sins are like scarlet, they shall be as white as snow" (Isaiah 1:18b). Our sins are washed away, perfectly atoned for by the precious blood of Christ. White is a symbol of purity and Jesus is the spotless Lamb of God; we believe that through Him His righteousness is imputed to every believer-so when the Father looks on us, He sees the pure, unfailing love and obedience of His only Son. Separated no more, we rejoice: But now in Christ Jesus you who once were far off have been brought near by the blood of Christ." (Eph 2:13)

Scripture Passage and Sermon Outline

Proclamation of God's Word

Text: Romans 8:5-17 (ESV) **Title:** God's Adopting Grace

Teacher: Tim Rice

⁵ For those who live according to the flesh set their minds on the things of the flesh, but those who live according to the Spirit set their minds on the things of the Spirit. ⁶ For to set the mind on the flesh is death, but to set the mind on the Spirit is life and peace. ⁷ For the mind that is set on the flesh is hostile to God, for it does not submit to God's law; indeed, it cannot. ⁸ Those who are in the flesh cannot please God. ⁹ You, however, are not in the flesh but in the Spirit, if in fact the Spirit of God dwells in you. Anyone who does not have the Spirit of Christ does not belong to him. ¹⁰ But if Christ is in you, although the body is dead because of sin, the Spirit is life because of righteousness. ¹¹ If the Spirit of Him who raised Jesus from the dead dwells in you, He who raised Christ Jesus from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies through His Spirit who dwells in you. ¹² So then, brothers, we are debtors, not to the flesh, to live according to the flesh. ¹³ For if you live according to the flesh you will die, but if by the Spirit you put to death the deeds of the body, you will live. ¹⁴ For all who are led by the Spirit of God are sons of God. ¹⁵ For you did not receive the spirit of slavery to fall back into fear, but you have received the Spirit of adoption as sons, by whom we cry, "Abba! Father!" ¹⁶ The Spirit himself bears witness with our spirit that we are children of God, ¹⁷ and if children, then heirs—heirs of God and fellow heirs with Christ, provided we suffer with Him in order that we may also be glorified with Him.

YOU CAN PRAY WITH US...

- 1. Worship the LORD for His infinite nature and that His Presence is inescapable. Praise Him, Father, Son and Holy Spirit for His kindness to dwell with us and adopt us as His own children in order to save us.
- 2. How have you doubted God's grace and lived as if He neither cares for your nor provides for you? Confess your unbelief to Jesus asking Him to forgive you and to change your heart.
- 3. Give thanks to Jesus for His incomparable love. Thank Him than He was willing to be cut off (dying on the Cross) so that you could be taken in, and that He gives you His all (His own Spirit) to secure you in His love.
- 4. Who do you know that is prone to fear or self-pity? Ask the Lord to help them, convincing them of His adopting love and His saving Presence.
- 5. Ask the Holy Spirit to persuade you of God's grace to adopt you, claiming you as His very own child. Pray for insight into what it means to belong to Him and His faithfulness as your loving Heavenly Father.
