CALL TO WORSHIP | Ephesians 3:20-21 (ESV)

Text: Mark 2:1-12 (ESV)
Title: Healing the Paralytic

YOU CAN PRAY WITH US ...

- 1. Worship the LORD our Healer for His mercy and goodness to broken people like us. Praise Him, Father, Son and Holy Spirit, that He works by His power, not to destroy us as He justly could, but to redeem us.
- 2. How have you lived either denying your brokenness or Jesus' power to make you whole? Confess your pride and unbelief to Him, asking Jesus to both forgive you and heal you just like this paralytic.
- 3. Give thanks to Jesus for His goodness to exercise His authority and power to redeem sinners like us. Thank Him for bearing what it cost to atone for all our sins (by His death) and to make us whole (His obedient life).
- 4. Who do you know that lives as if Jesus can't be trusted? Pray for them, asking the Lord to help them to see their own spiritual paralysis and that Jesus can be trusted to heal and forgive them.
- 5. Ask the Holy Spirit to bear in you His fruit of love, joy and faith. Pray that the Spirit would work in you to only trust Jesus' power and authority more and more as He works to forgive and heal even you.
