SONG OF GATHERING & PREPARATION

Goodness Of God

CALL TO WORSHIP | 2 Corinthians 1:20-22 (ESV)

We read God's Word, the Bible, together. It reveals to us who God is and what He expects of us.

For all the promises of God find their Yes in him. That is why it is through him that we utter our Amen to God for his glory. And it is God who establishes us with you in Christ, and has anointed us, and who has also put his seal on us and given us his Spirit in our hearts as a guarantee.

PRAYER OF ADORATION & CONFESSION

We pray together praising God for who He really is (Adoration) and admitting our inability to live up to what He expects of us (Confession).

ASSURANCE OF PARDON | 2 Corinthians 4:7-9, 16-18 (ESV)

We read God's Word together and are reminded that mercy and grace are freely given to all who have faith in Jesus Christ.

But we have this treasure in jars of clay, to show that the surpassing power belongs to God and not to us. We are afflicted in every way, but not crushed; perplexed, but not driven to despair; persecuted, but not forsaken; struck down, but not destroyed; ... So we do not lose heart. Though our outer self is wasting away, our inner self is being renewed day by day. For this light momentary affliction is preparing for us an eternal weight of glory beyond all comparison, as we look not to the things that are seen but to the things that are unseen. For the things that are seen are transient, but the things that are unseen are eternal.

We respond to the good news of God's mercy and grace for us in Jesus by giving generously to the work of His church and the kingdom of God.

CONFESSION OF FAITH

As an expression of our faith in Jesus Christ in solidarity with his people, we declare the substance of what we believe.

From the Heidelberg Catechism:

- Q.69. How does holy baptism remind and assure you that Christ's one sacrifice on the cross benefits you personally?
- A. In this way: Christ instituted this outward washing and with it promised that, as surely as water washes away the dirt from the body, so certainly his blood and his Spirit wash away my soul's impurity, that is, all my sins.
- Q. 70. What does it mean to be washed with Christ's blood and Spirit?
- A. To be washed with Christ's blood means that God, by grace, has forgiven our sins because of Christ's blood poured out for us in his sacrifice on the cross. To be washed with Christ's Spirit means that the Holy Spirit has renewed and sanctified us to be members of Christ, so that more and more we become dead to sin and live holy and blameless lives

SCRIPTURE PASSAGE & SERMON OUTLINE

Proclamation of God's Word

Text: 1 Peter 4:12-19 (ESV)
Title: Fiery Trials, Burning Glory

Teacher: Tim Rice

12 Beloved, do not be surprised at the fiery trial when it comes upon you to test you, as though something strange were happening to you. 13 But rejoice insofar as you share Christ's sufferings, that you may also rejoice and be glad when his glory is revealed. 14 If you are insulted for the name of Christ, you are blessed, because the Spirit of glory and of God rests upon you. 15 But let none of you suffer as a murderer or a thief or an evildoer or as a meddler. 16 Yet if anyone suffers as a Christian, let him not be ashamed, but let him glorify God in that name. 17 For it is time for judgment to begin at the household of God; and if it begins with us, what will be the outcome for those who do not obey the gospel of God? 18 And "If the righteous is scarcely saved, what will become of the ungodly and the sinner?" 19 Therefore let those who suffer according to God's will entrust their souls to a faithful Creator while doing good.

INTRO: How can you live in a world that rejects your values?

GLORY REVEALED & RESTING

How is the LORD holy and glorious?

SURPRISE & SHAME Foolishly, how can we lose sight of eternity and the world's hatred?

GOSPEL PERSPECTIVE & HOPE

Why can we find our sense of security, worth, and joy in the LORD?

YOU CAN PRAY WITH US ...

- 1. Worship the LORD for His surpassing glory. Praise Him, Father, Son and Holy Spirit, that no one and nothing has greater power, worth, or beauty than He does.
- 2. How have you lived as if suffering for Jesus is a surprise? Or as if the rejection of others is a verdict on your soul? Confess your unbelief to Jesus, asking Him to forgive you and to secure you by His saving love.
- 3. Give thanks to Jesus for entering into our fires, insults, and shame to save us by His grace. Thank Him for guaranteeing hope *through* pain and the loss of temporary things because of the eternal glory He offers us instead.
- 4. Who do you know whose glory quotient (what or whom they typically look to for power, worth or beauty) is only in this world? Pray for them, asking the Lord to help them to see the difference between now and eternity, and between created things, and the LORD our Creator.
- 5. Ask the Holy Spirit to bear in you His fruit: love, joy, and patience. Pray that the Spirit would help you trust the bond you have with Jesus, the inexhaustible joy He gives, and that He is worth waiting for in this fallen realm.
