ASSURANCE OF PARDON | Ephesians 3:14-19 (ESV)

We read God's Word together and are reminded that mercy and grace are freely given to all who have faith in Jesus Christ.

For this reason I bow my knees before the Father, from whom every family in heaven and on earth is named, that according to the riches of his glory he may grant you to be strengthened with power through his Spirit in your inner being, so that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith—that you, being rooted and grounded in love, may have strength to comprehend with all the saints what is the breadth and length and height and depth, and to know the love of Christ that surpasses knowledge, that you may be filled with all the fullness of God.

From the Heidelberg Catechism:

Q. 27. What do you understand by the providence of God?

A. The almighty and ever present power of God by which God upholds, as with his hand, heaven and earth and all creatures, and so rules them that leaf and blade, rain and drought, fruitful and lean years, food and drink, health and sickness, prosperity and poverty— all things, in fact, come to us not by chance but by his fatherly hand.

Q. 28. How does the knowledge of God's creation and providence help us?

A. We can be patient when things go against us, thankful when things go well, and for the future we can have good confidence in our faithful God and Father that nothing in creation will separate us from his love. For all creatures are so completely in God's hand that without his will they can neither move nor be moved.

SCRIPTURE PASSAGE & SERMON OUTLINE

Proclamation of God's Word

Text: Psalm 113 (ESV) Title: The LORD, God of Wonders Teacher: Tim Rice

1 Praise the Lord! Praise, O servants of the Lord, praise the name of the Lord! 2 Blessed be the name of the Lord from this time forth and forevermore! 3 From the rising of the sun to its setting, the name of the Lord is to be praised! 4 The Lord is high above all nations, and his glory above the heavens! 5 Who is like the Lord our God, who is seated on high, 6 who looks far down on the heavens and the earth? 7 He raises the poor from the dust and lifts the needy from the ash heap, 8 to make them sit with princes, with the princes of his people. 9 He gives the barren woman a home, making her the joyous mother of children. Praise the Lord!

INTRO: The Hebrew term *Hallel* gives us the word Hallelujah.

INESCAPABLE WONDER What does it mean to praise?

THE DISLOCATION OF PRAISE

Why is God's work to gather or unify His people even necessary?

ULTIMATE CAUSE FOR PRAISE

How is the LORD incomparable in His mercy?

YOU CAN PRAY WITH US ...

- 1. Worship the LORD as the God of all time, space and creatures. Praise Him, Father, Son and Holy Spirit, that He is more worthy of joy and adoration than anything or anyone else in all existence.
- 2. How have you lived amazed by creation or the achievements of people while you have yawned at your Maker? Confess to Jesus how dislocated your worship really is, asking Him to forgive you and to heal your heart.
- 3. Give thanks to Jesus for His saving grace. Thank Him for stooping down immeasurably, to bear our guilt and shame, to raise us up to sit at His table and be in His family!
- 4. Who do you know that approaches God with a consumer's heart rather than an amazed heart? Pray for them, asking the Lord to help open their eyes to the wonder of His holiness and glory, and to meet them with His grace.
- 5. Ask the Holy Spirit to bear in you His fruit of love and joy. Pray for the Spirit's help in awakening you to the daily privilege of worshipping the LORD and being captivated by His power, worth and beauty.


