SONG OF GATHERING & PREPARATION

The people of God always sang as they ascended the hill in Jerusalem up to the temple to worship (see Psalms 120-134). We, as well, prepare our hearts, minds, and bodies for worship by singing about the God we serve.

Worthy Of Your Name

CALL TO WORSHIP | Psalm 34:8-10, 19-22 (ESV)

We read God's Word, the Bible, together. It reveals to us who God is and what He expects of us.

Oh, taste and see that the Lord is good! Blessed is the man who takes refuge in him! Oh, fear the Lord, you his saints, for those who fear him have no lack! The young lions suffer want and hunger; but those who seek the Lord lack no good thing. ... Many are the afflictions of the righteous, but the Lord delivers him out of them all. He keeps all his bones; not one of them is broken. Affliction will slay the wicked, and those who hate the righteous will be condemned. The Lord redeems the life of his servants; none of those who take refuge in him will be condemned.

PRAYER OF ADORATION & CONFESSION

We pray together praising God for who He really is (Adoration) and admitting our inability to live up to what He expects of us (Confession).

ASSURANCE OF PARDON | Corinthians 1:18-19, 22-24, 27-31 (ESV)

We read God's Word together and are reminded that mercy and grace are freely given to all who have faith in Jesus Christ.

The word of the cross is folly to those who are perishing, but to us who are being saved it is the power of God. For it is written, "I will destroy the wisdom of the wise, and the discernment of the discerning I will thwart." ... For Jews demand signs and Greeks seek wisdom, but we preach Christ crucified, a stumbling block to Jews and folly to Gentiles, but to those who are called, both Jews and Greeks, Christ the power of God and the wisdom of God. ... But God chose what is foolish in the world to shame the wise; God chose what is weak in the world to shame the strong; God chose what is low and despised in the world, even things that are not, to bring to nothing things that are, so that no human being might boast in the presence of God. And because of him you are in Christ Jesus, who became to us wisdom from God, righteousness and sanctification and redemption, so that, as it is written, "Let the one who boasts, boast in the Lord."

CONFESSION OF FAITH

As an expression of our faith in Jesus Christ in solidarity with his people, we declare the substance of what we believe.

From the Heidelberg Catechism:

- Q. 65. It is through faith alone that we share in Christ and all his benefits: where then does that faith come from?
- A. The Holy Spirit produces it in our hearts by the preaching of the holy gospel, and confirms it by the use of the holy sacraments.
- O. 66. What are sacraments?
- A. Sacraments are visible, holy signs and seals. They were instituted by God so that by our use of them he might make us understand more clearly the promise of the gospel, and seal that promise. And this is God's gospel promise: to grant us forgiveness of sins and eternal life by grace because of Christ's one sacrifice accomplished on the cross.

SCRIPTURE PASSAGE & SERMON OUTLINE

Proclamation of God's Word

Text: 1 Peter 3:8-17 (ESV)
Title: The Hope That Is In You

Teacher: Tim Rice

8 Finally, all of you, have unity of mind, sympathy, brotherly love, a tender heart, and a humble mind. 9 Do not repay evil for evil or reviling for reviling, but on the contrary, bless, for to this you were called, that you may obtain a blessing. 10 For "Whoever desires to love life and see good days, let him keep his tongue from evil and his lips from speaking deceit; 11 let him turn away from evil and do good; let him seek peace and pursue it. 12 For the eyes of the Lord are on the righteous, and his ears are open to their prayer. But the face of the Lord is against those who do evil." 13 Now who is there to harm you if you are zealous for what is good? 14 But even if you should suffer for righteousness' sake, you will be blessed. Have no fear of them, nor be troubled, 15 but in your hearts honor Christ the Lord as holy, always being prepared to make a defense to anyone who asks you for a reason for the hope that is in you; yet do it with gentleness and respect, 16 having a good conscience, so that, when you are slandered, those who revile your good behavior in Christ may be put to shame. 17 For it is better to suffer for doing good, if that should be God's will, than for doing evil.

INTRO: What typically happens to your joy when your circumstances turn?

FEAR WITHIN, FIGHTING WITHOUT

Because of unbelief in a fallen world, how is ridicule inevitable?

CHRIST THE LORD IS HOLY What can secure us or motivate us to live this way?

THE PROVERBIAL TUBE OF TOOTHPASTE

When squeezed, what is inside comes out ...

YOU CAN PRAY WITH US ...

- 1. Worship the LORD that He is the Source of all goodness and blessing. Praise Him, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, that He is gracious to work for our benefit when He could justly condemn us.
- 2. How have you lived with earthly and time-bound definitions of blessing, vs. trusting Jesus' Word and His work to turn evil to good? *Confess your pride and unbelief to Jesus, asking Him to forgive you and change your perspective*.
- 3. Give thanks to Jesus for how He is incomparable and that His work to save us is sufficient. Thank Him for His work to secure us eternally, and His ability to turn even our trials and hardships to "an eternal weight of glory."
- 4. Who do you know that is shaken by earthly trials and fearful of ridicule for their faith? Pray for them, asking the Lord to secure them within and sustain them for whatever hardships they now have to face.
- 5. Ask the Holy Spirit to bear in you His fruit of love, joy, and patience. Pray that the Spirit would work into you Jesus' character, so that whenever you are squeezed, as it were, that His graciousness would come out of you.
