SONG OF GATHERING & PREPARATION

The people of God always sang as they ascended the hill in Jerusalem up to the temple to worship (see Psalms 120-134). We, as well, prepare our hearts, minds, and bodies for worship by singing about the God we serve.

Ancient Of Days

CALL TO WORSHIP | 1 Corinthians 15:1-6 (ESV)

We read God's Word, the Bible, together. It reveals to us who God is and what He expects of us.

Now I would remind you, brothers, of the gospel I preached to you, which you received, in which you stand, and by which you are being saved, if you hold fast to the word I preached to you—unless you believed in vain. For I delivered to you as of first importance what I also received: that Christ died for our sins in accordance with the Scriptures, that he was buried, that he was raised on the third day in accordance with the Scriptures, and that he appeared to Cephas, then to the twelve. Then he appeared to more than five hundred brothers at one time, most of whom are still alive, though some have fallen asleep.

PRAYER OF ADORATION & CONFESSION

We pray together praising God for who He really is (Adoration) and admitting our inability to live up to what He expects of us (Confession).

ASSURANCE OF PARDON | Romans 4:1-5 (ESV)

We read God's Word together and are reminded that mercy and grace are freely given to all who have faith in Jesus Christ.

What then shall we say was gained by Abraham, our forefather according to the flesh? For if Abraham was justified by works, he has something to boast about, but not before God. For what does the Scripture say? "Abraham believed God, and it was counted to him as righteousness." Now to the one who works, his wages are not counted as a gift but as his due. And to the one who does not work but believes in him who justifies the ungodly, his faith is counted as righteousness.

WORSHIP THROUGH GIVING

We respond to the good news of God's mercy and grace for us in Jesus by giving generously to the work of His church and the kingdom of God.

- O. 67. What is the sixth commandment?
- A. The sixth commandment is, *Thou shalt not kill*.
- Q. 68. What is required in the sixth commandment?
- A. The sixth commandment requires all lawful endeavors to preserve our own life, and the life of others.
- Q. 69. What is forbidden in the sixth commandment?
- A. The sixth commandment forbids the taking away of our own life, or the life of our neighbor, unjustly, or whatsoever tends to that.

SCRIPTURE PASSAGE & SERMON OUTLINE

Proclamation of God's Word

Text: Galatians 3:1-9 (ESV)

Title: The Spell of Self-Salvation

Teacher: David Springer

1 O foolish Galatians! Who has bewitched you? It was before your eyes that Jesus Christ was publicly portrayed as crucified. 2 Let me ask you only this: Did you receive the Spirit by works of the law or by hearing with faith? 3 Are you so foolish? Having begun by the Spirit, are you now being perfected by the flesh? 4 Did you suffer so many things in vain—if indeed it was in vain? 5 Does he who supplies the Spirit to you and works miracles among you do so by works of the law, or by hearing with faith— 6 just as Abraham "believed God, and it was counted to him as righteousness"? 7 Know then that it is those of faith who are the sons of Abraham. 8 And the Scripture, foreseeing that God would justify the Gentiles by faith, preached the gospel beforehand to Abraham, saying, "In you shall all the nations be blessed." 9 So then, those who are of faith are blessed along with Abraham, the man of faith.

YOU CAN PRAY WITH US ...

- 1. Praise God for being the author and perfecter of our faith. Praise the risen Christ, for the salvation that is only offered to us in the Gospel. Praise the Holy Spirit for His miraculous role in our salvation and sanctification.
- 2. Consider where we have deviated from the one true Gospel, in foolish attempts to add to the finished work of Christ. Confess where you are trusting in your works to validate your standing before God.
- 3. Give thanks to God for His unmerited favor and for the miraculous gift of faith. Thank Jesus for His sacrificial death and the Spirit's work in our lives!
- 4. Who do you know that is under the spell of a works-based righteousness? How can you relate to them and offer them the hope of the Gospel?
- 5. Ask the Spirit to see the Gospel with clarity. Pray that God would help us to rest in His covenant promises and to rely on His miraculous work.
