Constant of the immediate aftermath of their first sin Adam and Eve felt shame, covered their nakedness and hid from God. When God found them and called to them they did what so many of us have learned to do. Instead of immediately acknowledging and confessing their sin they began to point fingers. This morning we continue in our sermon series on the subject of repentance and we worship the God who condemned sin in his Son, the second Adam."


