ere at Trinity we typically take a break from our regularly scheduled programming to mark and celebrate significant moments in the life of our Lord. So at Christmas we delight in his incarnation; on Good Friday we ponder his suffering and death; and on Easter Sunday we rejoice in his resurrection. This morning we celebrate the ascension of our Lord into heaven and we worship Jesus who, with flesh and bones, returned to heaven."
