We Confess Our Faith | HEIDELBERG CATECHISM, QUESTION 1

What is your only comfort in life and in death?

Questions for family Worship And Community Groups

1. Paul prays that the Ephesian believers would see the hope, inheritance, and power they already have in Christ. What are the blindfolds in your life (and Trinity’s) that keep you/us from seeing spiritual realities? Confess those to someone.

2. Paul describes God’s power as the same power that raised Jesus from the dead. How does this change the way we think about struggles with sin, fear, or feelings of inadequacy? Where in your life are you hesitant to rely on God’s power instead of your own strength and resourcefulness?

3. If the Christian life is not about earning something new but about seeing what we already have in Christ, how does this change the way we approach spiritual growth, prayer,

and daily sin struggles? How can we practically encourage one another to live in the reality of this truth?

CHILDREN’S QUESTIONS:

1. What do you think it means to have “the eyes of your heart” opened? How is that different from just using our regular eyes?

2. Paul says that we have hope, worth, and power in Jesus. Can you think of a time when knowing that God was with you made you feel brave or special?

3. If God already gives us hope, love, and strength, why do we sometimes forget? What are some ways we can remind ourselves every day that Jesus died and rose again to give you these things?
