## We are Changed By God's Word | EPHESIANS 1:3-14

[3] Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us in Christ with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places, [4] even as he chose us in him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and blameless before him. In love [5] he predestined us for adoption to himself as sons through Jesus Christ, according to the purpose of his will, [6] to the praise of his glorious grace, with which he has blessed us in the Beloved. [7] In him we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of our trespasses, according to the riches of his grace, [8] which he lavished upon us, in all wisdom and insight [9] making known to us the mystery of his will, according to his purpose, which he set forth in Christ [10] as a plan for the fullness of time, to unite all things in him, things in heaven and things on earth.

[11] In him we have obtained an inheritance, having been predestined according to the purpose of him who works all things according to the counsel of his will, [12] so that we who were the first to hope in Christ might be to the praise of his glory. [13] In him you also, when you heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation, and believed in him, were sealed with the promised Holy Spirit, [14] who is the guarantee of our inheritance until we acquire possession of it, to the praise of his glory.

**QUESTIONS FOR FAMILY WORSHIP OR COMMUNITY GROUPS:** *THE FOLLOWING QUESTIONS HELP US DIALOG WITH THE SERMON, MUSIC, AND LITURGY IN THIS MORNING'S WORSHIP SERVICE. ### COMMUNITY GROUP QUESTIONS:

1. In verse 13, Paul uses the word σφραγίζω (sphragizō), meaning “sealed,” to describe the work of the Holy Spirit. A seal in ancient times represented ownership, security, and authenticity. How does understanding this deepen your assurance of belonging to God? How does it challenge the way you think about your identity in Christ?
2. The word ἀρραβών (arrabōn) in verse 14, meaning “guarantee” or “down payment,” emphasizes that the Holy Spirit is both a present assurance and a taste of what's to come. How does this truth help you face uncertainties in your life right now? In what ways can you live with greater confidence because of this promise?

### CHILDREN'S QUESTIONS:

1. In the Bible, Paul says that when we believe in Jesus, we are “sealed” by the Holy Spirit. A seal is like a stamp that shows something belongs to someone. What does it mean to you that God has put His special “stamp” on you? How does that make you feel?
2. Paul says the Holy Spirit is like a “guarantee” or a “promise” that we will live with God forever. Do you know what a promise is? Can you think of a time someone made a promise to you? How does it feel to know that God always keeps His promises?
3. Paul says everything God does for us is so we can show how awesome He is. What is one way you can show others how great God is this week—maybe at school, at home, or with your friends?

*Sermon in a Sentence:* Your salvation has been signed by God’s sovereign plan, sealed with the Holy Spirit, and guaranteed for delivery into eternal glory—all for the praise of His name.

Give me an understanding of you that is coherent, convincing, and that leads me to the life you promise. Grant that I might be undaunted by the cost of following you as I consider the reasons for doing so. Amen.

***Prayer of Belief:*** Lord Jesus Christ, I confess that I am weaker and more sinful than I ever dare imagine, but through you I am more loved and accepted than I ever dare dream. Thank you for paying my debt on the cross, taking what I deserved in order to offer me complete forgiveness and making me righteous before my Heavenly Father. Knowing that you have been raised from the dead, I turn from my sins and receive you as my Savior and Lord. Amen.

***Prayer of Commitment:*** Lord Jesus, you have called us to follow you in baptism and in a life of committed discipleship through membership in your church. Grant that I may take the necessary steps to be one with your people and live in the fullness of your Spirit. Amen.
