Preparation for Worship

Pentecost marks the dawn of a new era—a moment when the Holy Spirit is poured out, equipping the Church to carry Christ’s message to the ends of the earth. As we celebrate Pentecost, we give thanks for Christ’s unwavering faithfulness in keeping His promise to send the Comforter (John 14:16). We rejoice in the Spirit’s work of renewing all things, anchor our assurance in the Spirit’s power to carry out our mission, and freshly consider the vast scope of our calling: to bring the hope of the gospel to the whole world.

God Calls Us to Worship | Psalm 104:1-4

We Listen to God's Word | Acts 2 (Page 1081 in Chair Bibles)

Koine Greek - *Blake Altman*

[1] When the day of Pentecost arrived, they were all together in one place. [2] And suddenly there came from heaven a sound like a mighty rushing wind, and it filled the entire house where they were sitting.

Latin - *Vivian Thorpe*

[3] And divided tongues as of fire appeared to them and rested on each one of them. [4] And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other tongues as the Spirit gave them utterance.

[5] Now there were dwelling in Jerusalem Jews, devout men from every nation under heaven. [6] And at this sound the multitude came together, and they were bewildered, because each one was hearing them speak in his own language.

Arabic - *Anne Bedale*

[7] And they were amazed and astonished, saying, "Are not all these who are speaking Galileans? [8] And how is it that we hear, each of us in his own native language? [9] Parthians and Medes and Elamites and residents of Mesopotamia, Judea and Cappadocia,

Pontus and Asia, [10] Phrygia and Egypt and the parts of Libya belonging to Cyrene, and visitors from Rome, [11] both Jews and proselytes, Cretans and Arabians—we hear them telling in our own tongues the mighty works of God." [12] And all were amazed and perplexed, saying to one another, "What does this mean?" [13] But others mocking said, "They are filled with new wine."

Russian - *Mark Kunkee*

[14] But Peter, standing with the eleven, lifted up his voice and addressed them: "Men of Judea and all who dwell in Jerusalem, let this be known to you, and give ear to my words. [15] For these people are not drunk, as you suppose, since it is only the third hour of the day. [16] But this is what was uttered through the prophet Joel:

[17] "And in the last days it shall be, God declares, that I will pour out my Spirit on all flesh, and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, and your young men shall see visions, and your old men shall dream dreams; [18] even on my male servants and female servants in those days I will pour out my Spirit, and they shall prophesy. [19] And I will show wonders in the

heavens above and signs on the earth below, blood, and fire, and vapor of smoke; [20] the sun shall be turned to darkness and the moon to blood, before the day of the Lord comes, the great and magnificent day. [21] And it shall come to pass that everyone who calls upon the name of the Lord shall be saved.'

Spanish - *Claire Weber*

[22] "Men of Israel, hear these words: Jesus of Nazareth, a man attested to you by God with mighty works and wonders and signs that God did through him in your midst, as you yourselves know—[23] this Jesus, delivered up according to the definite plan and foreknowledge of God, you crucified and killed by the hands of lawless men. [24] God raised him up, loosing the pangs of death, because it was not possible for him to be held by it.

French - *Adrienne Nowakowski*

[25] For David says concerning him, "'I saw the Lord always before me, for he is at my right hand that I may not be shaken; [26] therefore my heart was glad, and my tongue rejoiced; my flesh also will dwell in hope. [27] For you will not abandon my soul to Hades, or let your Holy One see corruption. [28] You have made known to me the paths of life; you will make me full of gladness with your presence.' [29] "Brothers, I may say to you with confidence about the patriarch David that he both died and was buried, and his tomb is with us to this day. [30] Being therefore a prophet, and knowing that God had sworn with an oath to him that he would set one of his descendants on his throne, [31] he foresaw and spoke about the resurrection of the Christ, that he was not abandoned to Hades, nor did his flesh see corruption.

Italian - *Shar Agosto*

[32] This Jesus God raised up, and of that we all are witnesses. [33] Being therefore exalted at the right hand of God, and having received from the Father the

promise of the Holy Spirit, he has poured out this that you yourselves are seeing and hearing.

Kazakh - *Mark Kunkee*

[34] For David did not ascend into the heavens, but he himself says, "'The Lord said to my Lord, "Sit at my right hand, [35] until I make your enemies your footstool.'" [36] Let all the house of Israel therefore know for certain that God has made him both Lord and Christ, this Jesus whom you crucified." [37] Now when they heard this they were cut to the heart, and said to Peter and the rest of the apostles, "Brothers, what shall we do?" [38] And Peter said to them, "Repent and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins, and you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.

[39] For the promise is for you and for your children and for all who are far off, everyone whom the Lord our God calls to himself." [40] And with many other words he bore witness and continued to exhort them, saying, "Save yourselves from this crooked generation." [41] So those who received his word were baptized, and there were added that day about three thousand souls. [42] And they devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and the fellowship, to the breaking of bread and the prayers. [43] And awe came upon every soul, and many wonders and signs were being done through the apostles. [44] And all who believed were together and had all things in common. [45] And they were selling their possessions and belongings and distributing the proceeds to all, as any had need. [46] And day by day, attending the temple together and breaking bread in their homes, they received their food with glad and generous hearts, [47] praising God and having favor with all the people. And the Lord added to their number day by day those who were being saved. (ESV)

[26] Be angry and do not sin; do not let the sun go down on your anger, [27] and give no opportunity to the devil. [28] Let the thief no longer steal, but rather let him labor, doing honest work with his own hands, so that he may have something to share with anyone in need. [29] Let no corrupting talk come out of your mouths, but only such as is good for building up, as fits the occasion, that it may give grace to those who hear. [30] And do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God, by whom you were sealed for the day of redemption. [31] Let all bitterness and wrath and anger and clamor and slander be put away from you, along with all malice. [32] Be kind to one another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, as God in Christ forgave you. (ESV)

Questions for Family Worship and Community Groups

- 1. How does understanding that God's commands to "walk in a manner worthy of the calling" (Ephesians 4:1) change the way you view and respond to the instructions in Ephesians 4:25-32? Can you think of a recent time this perspective would have made a difference in your response to God's law?*
- 2. Paul roots each command in Ephesians 4:25-32 in a gospel reality. Which command or area—truthfulness, anger, generosity, speech, forgiveness—do you find most challenging, and how might remembering Christ's work and the Spirit's power specifically encourage you in that area?*
- 3. Calvin's "third use of the law" teaches that the law serves as a guide for grateful obedience rather than a means of earning God's favor. How can your community*

group encourage each other to walk in the Spirit and reflect the new humanity described in this passage? What are practical steps we can take together?

Children's Questions:

- 1. Why do you think God wants us to always tell the truth and be kind to each other? How does it help our friends and family when we do?*
- 2. The Holy Spirit helps us do what Jesus wants, like sharing possessions and forgiving others. Can you think of a time when you needed help to do something hard, like forgive or share? How did you ask God for help?*
- 3. Jesus always obeyed God, the Father, and showed love to everyone. What is one thing you can do this week to be more like Jesus at home, or with your friends?*
