Questions for Family Worship and Community Groups

- 1. Where in your life are you most tempted to rely on your own strength or goodness for your identity instead of trusting in what Jesus has done for you?*
- 2. Can you think of a time when you settled for small expectations of what God could do—either in your own heart, your family, or your community? What might it look like to “get your hopes up” and pray bigger prayers because of who God is?*
- 3. Paul says that God is able to do “far more abundantly than all we ask or think.” How does that encourage you to pray differently for yourself, your family, or your church? Is there something you*

need to start asking God for again? Are you okay with Him answering that prayer however He chooses?

CHILDREN'S QUESTIONS:

- 1. What is something you thought was too big or too hard for God to do? Why do you think the Bible says God can do even more than we can imagine?*
- 2. When you mess up or do something wrong, do you try to fix it yourself, or do you ask Jesus to help you? How does Jesus help us when we trust Him?*
- 3. If you could ask God for anything, what would you ask? Did you know God can do even more than that? Why is it good to talk to Him about everything?*
