We Confess our Faith | APOSTLES' CREED (4TH CENTURY)

Christian, what do you believe?

He suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died, and was buried; he descended into hell. The third day he rose again from the dead. * The word catholic (little "c") means universal and refers to the church throughout time and space; it is not referring to the Roman Catholic Church.

Praver of Belief: Lord Jesus Christ, I confess that I am weaker and more sinful than I ever dare imagine, but through you I am more loved and accepted than I ever dare dream. Thank you for paying my debt on the cross, taking what I deserved in order to offer me complete forgiveness and making me righteous before my Heavenly

Father. Knowing that you have been raised from the dead. I turn from my sins and receive you as my Savior and Lord. Amen
