Music Notes | DAVID LEPINE, TRINITY MUSIC DIRECTOR

You don't have to spend very much time in the PCA before you hear the music of Indelible Grace. Formed at RUF, Belmont, Indelible Grace was a group of songwriters led by PCA minister Kevin Twit, and they became one of the pillars of the "re-tuned hymns" movement of the 2000s, which undertook to write new melodies for old hymn texts. And indeed, our own congregation at Trinity has sung many Indelible Grace tunes over the years.

Although wonderful to listen to on recordings and in concert, most of the Indelible Grace melodies can actually inhibit strong communal singing in the worship service due to their highly syncopated quality. In contrast, traditional hymn tunes were written with a clear sense of the metrical pulse of the song included in the melody line itself, which aids communal singing. As we seek to grow even more into a congregation that sings together skillfully, you may find that with certain hymn texts, we return to singing the original tune from the hymnal. Putting in the work to learn or re-learn to sing the original tune will lead to stronger congregational singing overall and add a depth of musical beauty for years (and generations!) to come.

This Sunday for All Saints Day, we have the opportunity to practice singing "For All the Saints" to the melody it's most commonly associated with, SINE NOMINE, composed by Ralph Vaughan Williams (1872-1958), a towering figure within English church music. Dr. Larry Roff, editor of the PCA's Trinity Hymnal and organist for the General Assembly, calls this pairing of text and melody a "glorious addition to the church's hymnody."

Thank you for paying my debt on the cross, taking what I deserved in order to offer me complete forgiveness and making me righteous before my Heavenly
