Music Notes | DAVID LEPINE, TRINITY MUSIC DIRECTOR

Our closing song this morning is the wonderful hymn "Guide Me O Thou Great Jehovah." The text was written in 1745 by the beloved Welsh poet William Williams, and translated into English in 1771 with the help of Peter Williams (no relation). We will sing it to the traditional tune CWM RHONDDA (Welsh for Rhondda Valley, a coal-mining region in Wales), composed by John Hughes in 1907.

Dr. Larry Roff, editor of the PCA's Trinity Hymnal, says about this hymn: "It would be difficult to find another hymn that included so much of the Bible, in less than a hundred words." Dr. Martyn Lloyd-Jones also praised Williams' poetry, commenting how remarkable it was to have "such an outstanding natural poet now under the influence of the Holy Spirit writing these incomparable hymns."

The text of the hymn portrays the Exodus of the Israelites in the Old Testament as an archetype for our own journey as Christians. We too, having been redeemed from bondage, must now trust our covenant Lord to guide us through the wilderness to the promised land.

CWM RHONDDA is an ideal complement to the text. Its singable, uplifting melody reinforces the truths we proclaim about God's faithfulness, helping to strengthen our "weak knees" that we may "run with endurance the race that is set before us" (Hebrews 12).
