BEAUTY OF THE CHURCH

PREPARATION FOR WORSHIP

Christ the King Sunday directs our attention to something fundamental: the cosmic scope of Christ's reign. It's not just about personal spirituality or private faith—it's a declaration that Jesus Christ is Lord over all creation. Everything—every system, every culture, every aspect of life—ultimately comes under His authority. This day calls for a response, inviting us to joyfully and willingly submit to His kingship, recognizing that to do so is not a burden, but the truest freedom.

Traditionally, Christ the King Sunday is celebrated on the final Sunday before Advent, serving as a bridge into the season where we anticipate not only Christ's first coming, but also His second. Advent reminds us of the already and the not-yet—Jesus has come, and He will come again. Christ the King Sunday, then, is a fitting context to prepare for Advent and conclude our series on the beauty of the church, for the church finds her lasting rest in the New Heavens and New Earth over which Jesus sovereignly rules with both justice and grace as the eternal Prince of Peace.

We Greet Others with Peace | COLOSSIANS 1:19-20

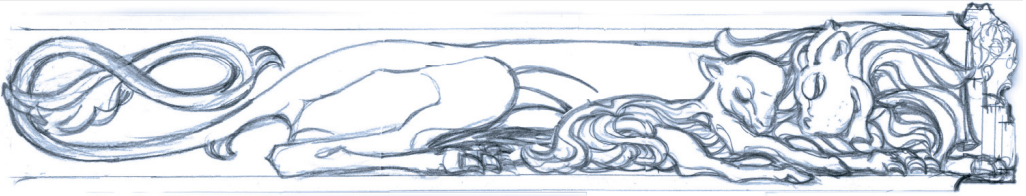

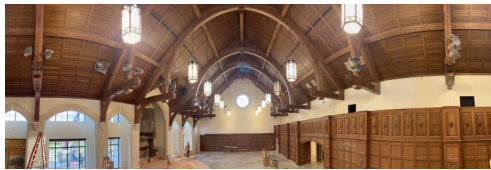

How to Respond to Today's Service?

1. BE STILL. PRAY AND REFLECT TODAY. You may want to pray something like this:

Prayer for Those Searching for the Truth:

Lord Jesus, you claim to be the way the truth and the life. If what you claim is true, please guide me, teach me and open me to the reality of who you are. Give me an understanding of you that is coherent, convincing, and that leads me to the life you promise. Grant that I might be undaunted by the cost of following you as I consider the reasons for doing so. Amen.

Prayer of Belief: Lord Jesus Christ, I confess that I am weaker and more sinful than I ever dare imagine, but through you I am more loved and accepted than I ever dare dream. Thank you for paying my debt on the cross, taking what I deserved in order to offer me complete forgiveness and making me righteous before my Heavenly

Father. Knowing that you have been raised from the dead, I turn from my sins and receive you as my Savior and Lord. Amen.

Prayer of Commitment: Lord Jesus, you have called us to follow you in baptism and in a life of committed discipleship through membership in your church. Grant that I may take the necessary steps to be one with your people and live in the fullness of your Spirit. Amen.

2. READ SCRIPTURE. Read the sermon passage again and reflect on what the Holy Spirit called to mind. How might you apply it with God's help?
