Lighting of the Advent Wreath | BETHLEHEM CANDLE

The third candle is called the "Shepherd's Candle." The third Sunday of Advent is Gaudete Sunday which comes from the Latin word meaning rejoice, and is meant to remind us of the joy that the world experienced at the birth of Jesus.

We light these candles as a sign of the coming light of Christ. Advent means coming.

We are preparing ourselves for the days when the nations shall beat their swords into plowshares, and their spears into pruning hooks; Nation shall not lift up sword against nation, neither shall they learn war any more.
