He suffered under Pontius Pilate,

He ascended into heaven and is seated at
the right hand of God the Father Almighty.***

***From there he will come to judge the
living and the dead.***

***I believe in the Holy Spirit,
the holy catholic church*,
the communion of saints,

We Are Changed by God's Word | PSALM 49

To the choirmaster. A Psalm of the Sons of Korah.

- [1] Hear this, all peoples!
Give ear, all inhabitants of the world,
- [2] both low and high,
rich and poor together!
- [3] My mouth shall speak wisdom;
the meditation of my heart shall be understanding.
- [4] I will incline my ear to a proverb;
I will solve my riddle to the music of the lyre.
- [5] Why should I fear in times of trouble,
when the iniquity of those who cheat me surrounds me,
- [6] those who trust in their wealth
and boast of the abundance of their riches?
- [7] Truly no man can ransom another,
or give to God the price of his life,
- [8] for the ransom of their life is costly
and can never suffice,
- [9] that he should live on forever
and never see the pit.
- [10] For he sees that even the wise die;
the fool and the stupid alike must perish
and leave their wealth to others.
- [11] Their graves are their homes forever,
their dwelling places to all generations,
though they called lands by their own names.
- [12] Man in his pomp will not remain;
he is like the beasts that perish.
- [13] This is the path of those who have foolish confidence;
yet after them people approve of their boasts. Selah
- [14] Like sheep they are appointed for Sheol;
death shall be their shepherd,
and the upright shall rule over them in the morning.
Their form shall be consumed in Sheol, with no place to dwell.
- [15] But God will ransom my soul from the power of Sheol,
for he will receive me. Selah
- [16] Be not afraid when a man becomes rich,
when the glory of his house increases.
- [17] For when he dies he will carry nothing away;
his glory will not go down after him.
- [18] For though, while he lives, he counts himself blessed
—and though you get praise when you do well for yourself—
- [19] his soul will go to the generation of his fathers,
who will never again see light.
- [20] Man in his pomp yet without understanding is like the beasts that perish.

How to Respond to Today's Service?

1. TAKE TIME FOR PRAYER AND REFLECTION.

You may want to pray something like this:

Prayer for Those Searching for the Truth: Lord Jesus, you claim to be the way the truth and the life. If what you claim is true, please guide me, teach me and open me to the reality of who you are. Give me an understanding of you that is coherent, convincing, and that leads me to the life you promise. Grant that I might be undaunted by the cost of following you as I consider the reasons for doing so. Amen.

Prayer of Belief: Lord Jesus Christ, I confess that I am weaker and more sinful than I ever dare imagine, but through you I am more loved and accepted than I ever dare dream. Thank you for paying my debt on the cross, taking what I deserved in order to offer me complete forgiveness and making me righteous before my Heavenly

Father. Knowing that you have been raised from the dead, I turn from my sins and receive you as my Savior and Lord. Amen.

Prayer of Commitment: Lord Jesus, you have called us to follow you in baptism and in a life of committed discipleship through membership in your church. Grant that I may take the necessary steps to be one with your people and live in the fullness of your Spirit. Amen.

2. READ SCRIPTURE. Read the sermon passage again and reflect on what the Holy Spirit called to mind. How might you apply it with God's help?
