We Are Changed by God's Word | PSALM 50

A Psalm of Asaph.

- [1] The Mighty One, God the LORD, speaks and summons the earth from the rising of the sun to its setting.
- [2] Out of Zion, the perfection of beauty, God shines forth.
- [3] Our God comes; he does not keep silence; before him is a devouring fire, around him a mighty tempest.
- [4] He calls to the heavens above and to the earth, that he may judge his people:
- [5] "Gather to me my faithful ones, who made a covenant with me by sacrifice!"
- [6] The heavens declare his righteousness, for God himself is judge! Selah
- [7] "Hear, O my people, and I will speak; O Israel, I will testify against you. I am God, your God.
- [8] Not for your sacrifices do I rebuke you; your burnt offerings are continually before me.
- [9] I will not accept a bull from your house or goats from your folds.
- [10] For every beast of the forest is mine, the cattle on a thousand hills.
- [11] I know all the birds of the hills, and all that moves in the field is mine.
- [12] "If I were hungry, I would not tell you, for the world and its fullness are mine.
- [13] Do I eat the flesh of bulls or drink the blood of goats?

- [14] Offer to God a sacrifice of thanksgiving, and perform your vows to the Most High,
- [15] and call upon me in the day of trouble; I will deliver you, and you shall glorify me."
- [16] But to the wicked God says: "What right have you to recite my statutes or take my covenant on your lips?
- [17] For you hate discipline, and you cast my words behind you.
- [18] If you see a thief, you are pleased with him, and you keep company with adulterers.
- [19] "You give your mouth free rein for evil, and your tongue frames deceit.
- [20] You sit and speak against your brother; you slander your own mother's son.
- [21] These things you have done, and I have been silent; you thought that I was one like yourself. But now I rebuke you and lay the charge before you.
- [22] "Mark this, then, you who forget God, lest I tear you apart, and there be none to deliver!
- [23] The one who offers thanksgiving as his sacrifice glorifies me; to one who orders his way rightly I will show the salvation of God!"

This is the Word of the Lord.

How to Respond to Today's Service?

1. SEEK STILLNESS FOR PRAYER AND REFLECTION TODAY. You may want to pray something like this:

Prayer for Those Searching for the Truth:

Lord Jesus, you claim to be the way the truth and the life. If what you claim is true, please guide me, teach me and open me to the reality of who you are. Give me an understanding of you that is coherent, convincing, and that leads me to the life you promise. Grant that I might be undaunted by the cost of following you as I consider the reasons for doing so. Amen.

Prayer of Belief: Lord Jesus Christ, I confess that I am weaker and more sinful than I ever dare imagine, but through you I am more loved and accepted than I ever dare dream. Thank you for paying my debt on the cross, taking what I deserved in order to offer me complete forgiveness and making me righteous before my Heavenly Father. Knowing that you have been raised from the dead, I turn from my sins and receive you as my Savior and Lord. Amen.

Prayer of Commitment: Lord Jesus, you have called us to follow you in baptism and in a life of committed discipleship through membership in your church. Grant that I may take the necessary steps to be one with your people and live in the fullness of your Spirit, Amen.

- 2. READ SCRIPTURE. Read the sermon passage again and reflect on what the Holy Spirit called to mind. How might you apply it with God's help?
