## We Confess Our Faith | PHILIPPIANS 2:5-11

### We Are Changed By God's Word | EPHESIANS 1:3-14

[3] Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us in Christ with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places, [4] even as he chose us in him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and blameless before him. In love [5] he predestined us for adoption to himself as sons through Jesus Christ, according to the purpose of his will, [6] to the praise of his glorious grace, with which he has blessed us in the Beloved. [7] In him we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of our trespasses, according to the riches of his grace, [8] which he lavished upon us, in all wisdom and insight [9] making known to us the mystery of his will, according to his purpose, which he set forth in Christ [10] as a plan for the fullness of time, to unite all things in him, things in heaven and things on earth.

[11] In him we have obtained an inheritance, having been predestined according to the purpose of him who works all things according to the counsel of his will, [12] so that we who were the first to hope in Christ might be to the praise of his glory. [13] In him you also, when you heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation, and believed in him, were sealed with the promised Holy Spirit, [14] who is the guarantee of our inheritance until we acquire possession of it, to the praise of his glory. (ESV)

#### QUESTIONS FOR FAMILY WORSHIP OR COMMUNITY GROUPS:

The following questions help us dialog with the sermon, music, and liturgy in this morning's worship service. **Remember, these** questions are just a starting point. Feel free to adapt them to the specific needs and interests of your family worship times and/or community group.

 Ephesians 1:3 says we are blessed with "every spiritual blessing in Christ." What does "spiritual blessing" mean in this context? How are these blessings different from material blessings, and why does Paul emphasize their significance?

2. In Ephesians 1:4, Paul says God chose us "before the foundation of the world." What does this reveal about God's plan for humanity and His character? How does this choice connect to our calling to live "holy and blameless" lives?

3. In Ephesians 1:5, Paul describes God adopting us into His family through Jesus. What did adoption signify in Roman culture, and how does that deepen our understanding of what it means to be God's children?

4. How does knowing you were chosen by God before the foundation of the world impact the way you see yourself and your worth? Are there areas in your life where you're still striving for approval from others rather than resting in God's unconditional love?

#### **Children's Questions:**

 What is a gift that someone gave you that made you really happy? Did you know that God has already given you the best gifts ever, like His love and forgiveness? What are some ways you can say "thank you" to God for those gifts?

2. How does it feel when someone picks you for their team or invites you to play with them? Did you know that God picked YOU to be part of His family? How can you remember this when you feel left out or sad? Sermon in a Sentence: You are blessed, chosen, and adopted by God—not because of who you are or what you've done, but because of who He is and His incredible love for you.

Knowing that you have been raised from the dead, I turn from my sins and receive you as my Savior and Lord. Amen.

**Prayer of Commitment:** Lord Jesus, you have called us to follow you in baptism and in a life of committed discipleship through membership in your church. Grant that I may take the necessary steps to be one with your people and live in the fullness of your Spirit. Amen.
