CHURCH PICNIC & AWANA GAMES

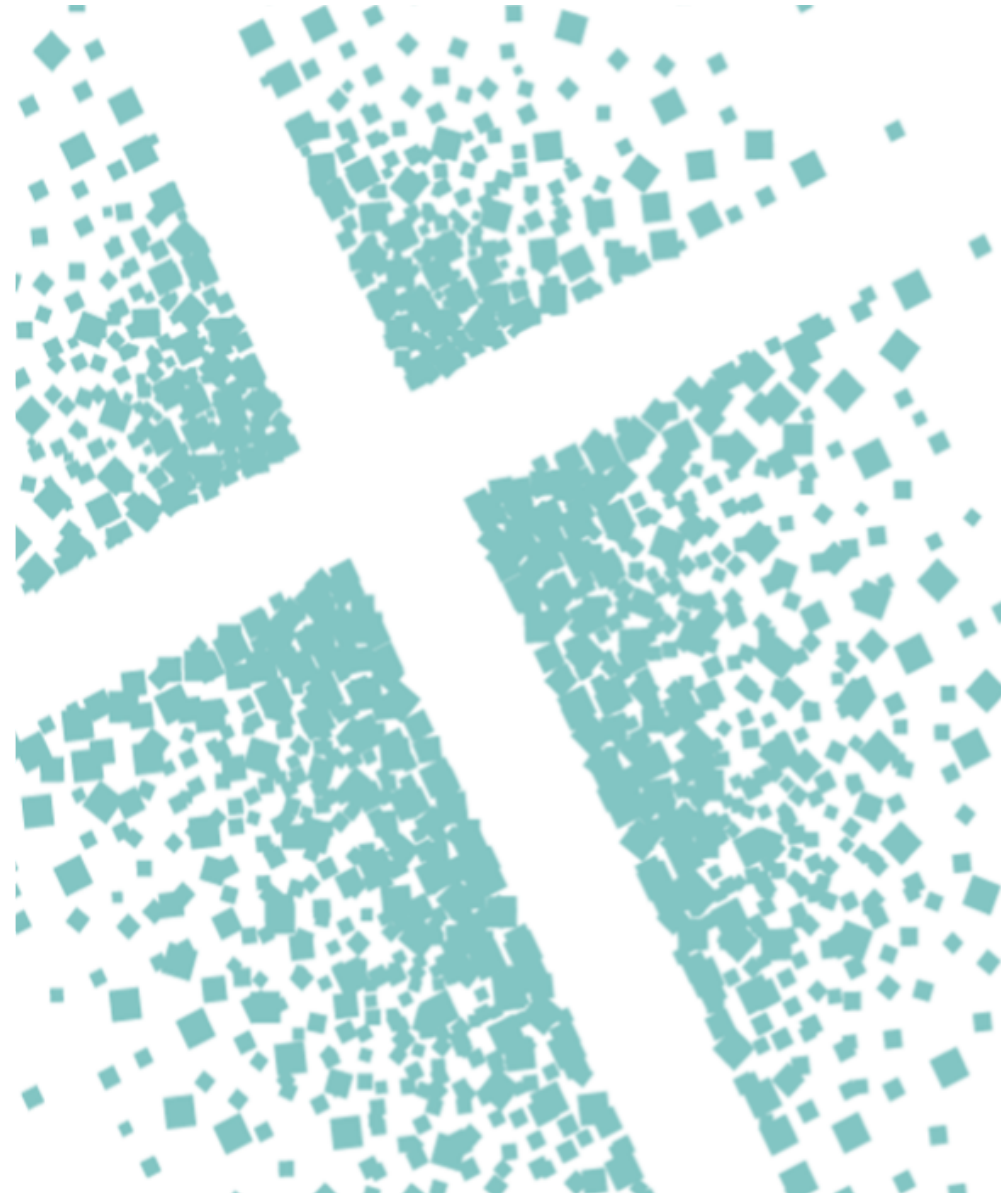
