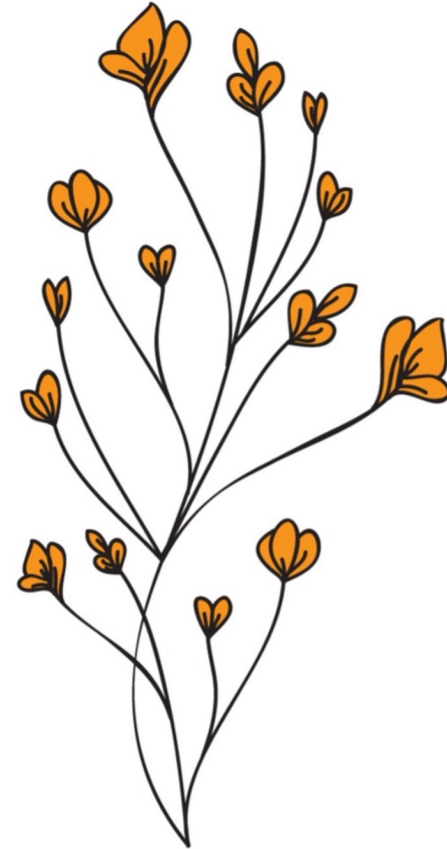
## SUMMER KICK-OFF BBQ PICNIC
