Preface to the Ordinal

The Holy Scriptures and ancient Christian writers make it clear that from the apostles' time, there have been different ministries within the Church. In particular, since the time of the New Testament, three distinct orders of ministers have been characteristic of Christ's holy catholic (universal) Church. First, there is the order of bishops who carry on the apostolic work of leading, supervising, and uniting the Church. Secondly, associated with them are the presbyters, or elders, in subsequent times generally known as priests. Together with the bishops, they take part in the governance of the Church, in the carrying out of its missionary and pastoral work, and in the preaching of the Word of God and administering His holy Sacraments. Thirdly, there are minsters and deacons, who assist elders in all of this work. Ministers assist the eldership in the spiritual oversight of the local church body, while deacons assist the ministers to minister in Christ's Name to the poor, the sick, the suffering and the helpless of the local church body.

The persons who are appointed and recognized by the Church as being called by God to the ministry are admitted to these sacred orders by solemn prayer and the laying on of hands. It has been, and is, the intention and purpose of this church to maintain and continue these three orders; and for this purpose these services of licensing and installation with consecration are appointed. No persons are allowed to exercise the offices of bishop, elder, minister, deacon, in this Church unless they are so licensed or installed, or having already received such license or ordination with the laying on of hands by individuals themselves who are duly qualified to confer Holy Orders.

It is also recognized and affirmed that these ministries are not the exclusive property of this portion of Christ's universal Church, but rather gifts from God for the nurture of His people and the proclamation of His Gospel everywhere. Accordingly, the manner of licensing and installation in this Church is to be such as has been, and is the most generally recognized by Christian people as suitable for conferring the sacred orders of bishop, elder, minister and deacon.





Will you strive to be a faithful Minister to all whom you are called to serve, laboring together with them and with your fellow ministers to build up the family of God?

ANSWER: I will.

ELDER MARCUS:

Will you do your best to pattern your life and that of your household in accordance with the teachings of Christ, so that you may be a wholesome example to the people?

ANSWER: I will.

BISHOP:

Will you persevere in prayer, both in public and in private, asking God's grace, both for yourself and for others, offering all your labors to God, through the mediation of Jesus Christ, and in the sanctification of the Holy Spirit?

ANSWER: I will.

The Examination (cont.)

PASTOR ISHA:

Do you, with the churches throughout the world accept the scriptures of the Old and New Testament as the inerrant Word of God, the rule and standard of Christian faith and practice?

ANSWER: I do.

ELDER DAVID:

Do you promise to be diligent in your private prayers and in reading the scriptures, as well as the public duties of your office?

ANSWER: I do, relying on God.

ELDER CAROLINE:

Will you be zealous in ministering both the truth of the gospel, in administering the sacraments and rites of the church, and in exercising leadership?

ANSWER: I will, relying on God's grace.

FLDER RON:

Will you keep all confidences shared with you?

ANSWER: I will, relying on God's grace.

ELDER MICHELLE:

Will you seek to regard all people with equal love and concern and undertake to minister impartially to the needs of all?

ANSWER: I will, relying on God's grace.

ELDER MARCUS:

Having prayerfully considered the duties and responsibilities of the minister of the gospel, are you prepared to serve with the help of God in Christ's name and for the glory of God?

ANSWER: I am.

BISHOP, PASTOR ISHA AND THE ELDERS:

May the Lord who has given to you the will to do these things give you the grace and power to perform them.

ANSWER: Amen.

The Charge

ELDER DAVID:

We charge you to know the truth. As Paul instructed Timothy, "Be diligent to present yourself approved to God as a workman who does not need to be ashamed, handling accurately the Word of truth."

—2 Timothy 2:15

ELDER CAROLINE:

We charge you to preach the truth. Though the message of the cross is "foolishness" to those who are perishing, yet "God was well pleased through the foolishness of the message preached to save those who believe." —1 Corinthians 1:18,21

ELDER RON:

We charge you to live the truth. Keep your personal character blameless. Lay the law of kindness upon your heart and tongue. Be a servant, not a master. Persuasion is more effective than force. Lead by example. —Matthew 5:16

ELDER MICHELLE:

We charge you to always be directed by the truth. Knowing the truth is what will always make you and keep you free. We charge you, know the truth, preach the truth, live the truth and walk in truth all the days of your life. —John 8:32

ELDER MARCUS:

Finally we charge you to stand unwavering on the foundation of God's Word. Watch, stand fast in the faith, be brave, be strong. Let all that you do be done with love(1 Corinthians 16:13-14). Do not waver in the face of opposition or be swayed by the winds of deception. Clothe yourself in the full armor of God so that you may be able to withstand the schemes of the enemy. —Ephesians 6:11

The Consecration

+All the people stand, except the candidates, who kneel before for the laying on of hands upon the candidates.

BISHOP:

Each candidate shall now kneel. Pastor Isha and I along with The Elders, will now anoint you with oil and laying of hands for service in the Church of Jesus Christ.

The prayer continues as the Eldership place their right hands upon the heads of the candidates saying together:

"Therefore, Father, make these Ministerial Candidates ministers in your Church. Pour out upon then your princely Spirit, whom you bestowed upon your beloved Son Jesus Christ, with whom He endowed the apostles, and by whom your Church is built up in every place, to the glory and unceasing praise of your Name."

The prayer will conclude with the people responding in a loud voice together after Bishop says:

AND ALL THE PEOPLE SAID: Amen!

The Directive

BISHOP:

Ministers, please rise and stand before us in your new Office of a Minister.

The Giving *of* Gifts and Credentials

The new Ministers shall now be presented a ministers cross and bible along with ministerial credentials (which include certificate of License and ministerial papers).

BISHOP:

Receive the ministerial cross, credentials and bible as a sign of the authority given to you to preach the Word of God and to administer His Holy ordinances. Do not forget the trust committed to you as Ministers in this church.

PASTORAL DECLARATION:

In the name of Jesus Christ the head of the church by the authority of Victory In Christ Christian Center, We declare these individuals to be licensed as ministers of the gospel of Jesus Christ, to serve in the Body of Christ. May the Holy Spirit strengthen you for the ministry of The Gospel and equip you with everything good to do God's will.

The Presentation of New Ministers

+ All stand as the new Ministers are presented to the People.

The People offer their acclamation and applause in response to their consecration.

The new Ministers will now take their rightful place on the altar amongst the Eldership as they prepare to consecrate the deacon candidates.

The Invitation to Deacon Candidates

ELDER DAVE:

The qualifications for the Office of Deacon are set forth by the Apostle Paul in the third chapter of his First Epistle to Timothy, in which he says:

"Deacons must be worth of respect, not shifty and double talkers but sincere in what they say, not given to much wine, not greedy for base gain, craving wealth and resorting to ignoble and dishonest methods of getting it."

ELDER CAROLINE:

"They must be earnest, wholehearted followers of Christ, who is the hidden Source of their faith."

ELDER MARCUS:

"Before they are asked to be deacons, they should be given other jobs in the church as a test of their character and ability, and if they do well, then they may be chosen as deacons."

ELDER MICHELLE:

"The women also must be worthy of respect and serious, not gossipers, but temperate and self-controlled, thoroughly trustworthy in all things."

ELDER RON:

"Let the deacons be the spouse of one person, and let them manage their children and their own households well. Those who do well as deacons will be well rewarded both by respect from others and also by developing their own confidence and bold trust in the Lord."

BISHOP:

During this past year, the candidates for the Office of a Deacon have been examined, proven by Pastor Isha and I and the Elders and appointed in accordance with the Scriptural qualifications of this Church.

During the past several weeks, the believers who are joined to this Local Church family were asked to seriously consider these candidates for approval of them before installing them today to the Office of a Deacon. I now ask the partners of this Church, do you believe they will be faithful servants who will be rewarded by the respect of others and their trust in the Lord?

THE CONGREGATION SAYS: We do.

PASTOR ISHA:

To the Deacon Candidates we the Presbytery and ministerial staff of this church invite you to come forward for public examination as a sign of your consent to receive installation into this Office of Deacon.

The Examination

BISHOP AND PASTOR ISHA:

We ask each Candidate to carefully and prayerfully consider the spiritual commitment and obligations which your office that you are appointed to fulfill carries. With a just appreciation of these, do you accept the Office of a Deacon, and with the help of the Holy Spirit, will you diligently seek to perform the responsibilities of whatever needs may be required of you, and also do those things which make for peace, purity and spiritual growth of this local Church family that you shall serve?

RESPONSE BY DEACON CANDIDATES:

I will, and I solemnly declare that I desire to fulfill the office of a deacon and I solemnly engage to commit myself to this sacred trust.

ELDERS:

Will you be loyal to your Pastors, The Elders, Ministers, and Church family?

RESPONSE BY DEACON CANDIDATES:

I will be loyal and guard the responsibility of service to my Pastors, The Elders, Ministers and Church family.

MINISTERS GROUP 1:

Will you accept this appointment and fulfill this trust in obedience to Christ?

RESPONSE BY DEACON CANDIDATES:

I will obey Christ, and will serve in His Name.

MINISTERS GROUP 2:

Will you endeavor to be a faithful servant in the Body of Christ?

RESPONSE BY DEACON CANDIDATES:

With God's help, I will.

MINISTERS GROUP 3:

Will you aid and assist the equipping of the saints of God for their ministry and mission?

RESPONSE BY DEACON CANDIDATES:

With God's help, I will.

MINISTERS GROUP 4:

Will you herald the Good News of Jesus Christ to those outside the community of faith, stand alongside those who suffer, and work for justice and peace in the world?

RESPONSE BY DEACON CANDIDATES:

With God's help, I will.

MINISTERS GROUP 1:

Will you rely on the power of the Holy Spirit? Will you be disciplined in the study of the Word of God and seek to live a holy and disciplined life?

RESPONSE BY DEACON CANDIDATES:

With God's help, I will.

MINISTERS GROUP 2:

Will you be faithful in praying for your Pastors, Elders, ministers and the Church family?

RESPONSE BY DEACON CANDIDATES:

With God's help, I will.

The Examination (cont.)

MINISTERS GROUP 3:

Will you strive for peace and unity among all Christian people; especially among those whom you serve?

RESPONSE BY DEACON CANDIDATES:

With God's help, I will.

MINISTERS GROUP 4:

Do you accept and believe the doctrines, teachings and creeds within this local assembly as safeguards and witnesses to the faith of the Lord Jesus Christ?

RESPONSE BY DEACON CANDIDATES:

I do.

ELDERS:

Will you use these precious doctrines, teachings and creeds in worship and instruction for righteous living?

RESPONSE BY DEACON CANDIDATES:

With God's help, I will.

ELDERS:

Through these promises, you have committed yourself to God, to serve His Church in the Office of a Deacon, We therefore hold you accountable in the presence of God and all of these witness to fulfill this sacred trust established here today.

RESPONSE BY DEACON CANDIDATES:

With God's help, I will.

ELDERS:

Will you honor and guard the doctrine, discipline and worship of Christ as this Church has received them?

RESPONSE BY DEACON CANDIDATES:

I will honor and guard the doctrine, discipline and worship of Christ as this Church has received them.

The Consecration

(Installation Anointing)

BISHOP:

Each candidate shall now kneel. Pastor Isha and I along with The Elders, will now anoint you with oil and laying of hands for service in the Church of Jesus Christ.

The Consecration

(Installation Prayer) + The Congregation Shall Stand.

BISHOP:

My brothers and sisters, as you have been duly appointed and confirmed by the Presbytery and Church family to serve as deacons, we now install you to the Office of a Deacon in the church of our Lord Jesus Christ, which He purchased by His own blood.

The Consecration

(Installation Directive)

BISHOP:

Deacons, please rise and stand before us in your new Office of a Deacon.

PASTOR ISHA:

Will the congregation please join me in saying the Lord's Prayer:

Our Father which art in heaven,
Hallowed be thy name.
Thy kingdom come.
Thy will be done in earth, as [it is] in heaven.
Give us this day our daily bread.
And forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors.
And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil:
For thine is the kingdom, and the power;
And the glory, forever.

BISHOP AND PASTOR ISHA SAY IN INTERVAL:

Will the congregation please stand. Deacons, please turn and face the congregation.

In as much as you have declared your willingness to accept your appointment to the Office of a Deacon, and you have expressed your sincere desire to discharge its responsibilities faithfully, and you have received the laying on of hands for the attendant blessing of God, you are now formally accepted in your installation and declared to be deacons in this local church expression.

May you show yourselves to be men and women of God, thoroughly furnished unto all good works. May the Spirit of Christ, who came "not to be ministered unto, but to minister," dwell in you richly, make you always faithful in the performance of the servant responsibilities you now assume, and cause you to serve in godly wisdom and Christ loving care to the flock of God.

Victory In Christ Christian Center Family, let us welcome the New Installed Deacons with an ovation of praise to the Lord for the great things He has done in our midst!
