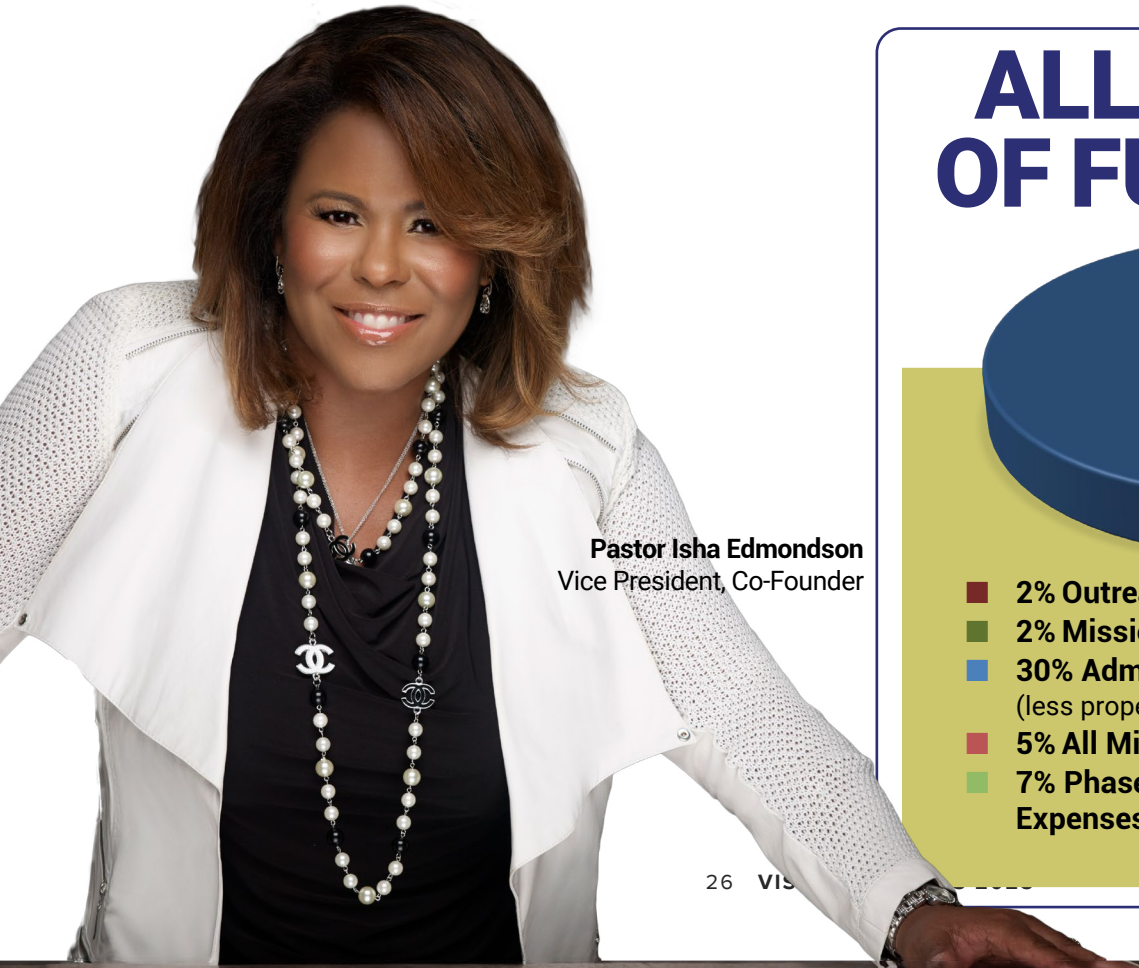
FINANCIAL REPORT

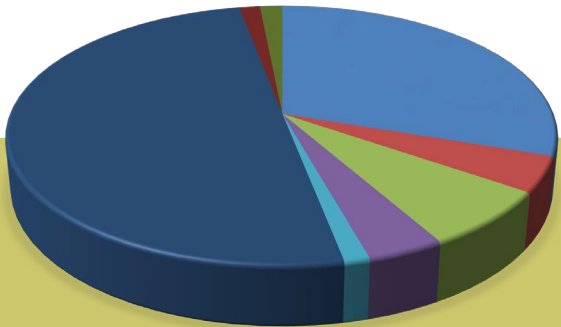

Prayer and CONSECRATION

INTENTIONAL FAITH

THIS YEAR OF INTENTIONAL FAITH will bring a wide variety of faith challenges. This year, the Lord has instructed us to set aside multiple times of corporate consecration in prayer and fasting.

Consecration is the ultimate act of surrender, setting ourselves apart for God's use and aligning with His divine purpose. It is not just a momentary decision but a lifestyle of holiness, obedience, and unwavering faith. As Romans 12:1 (KJV) exhorts us, *"I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service."*

During these set aside times we will assist you with practical steps to help our church family fully dedicate themselves to God. This is not just another thing on the calendar; it is a prophetic invitation to step into a deeper dimension of intentional faith and devotion in 2025.

In this season, God is calling us to consecrate:

- **OUR LIVES:** To live as vessels of honor, set apart for His glory.
- **OUR TALENTS:** To use our gifts for kingdom advancement.
- **OUR TIME:** To prioritize His presence and His work.
- **OUR TREASURE:** To sow into His kingdom as a demonstration of trust and obedience.

This is a divine moment to draw closer to Him, to set aside distractions, and to dedicate ourselves fully to His will.

As Joshua declared to the Israelites, *"Sanctify yourselves: for tomorrow the Lord will do wonders among you"* (Joshua 3:5, KJV). I believe that as we consecrate ourselves, we will experience the wonders of God in ways we have never seen before.

The act of consecration is more than a devotion, it is a spiritual principle that activates a response from God. When we consecrate ourselves, we create an atmosphere for His presence, provision,

plans, and power to manifest in our lives. As we surrender fully to Him, He moves supernaturally, aligning His blessings with our faith and obedience.

We see God's hand at work through consecration, providing angelic interventions, supernatural supply, and divine strategies. It is a powerful catalyst that opens the door for His favor, guidance, and transformative breakthroughs.

When you embrace consecration as a principle, you position yourself for God's promises and manifestations, including:

1. **REVELATION:** Fresh insight and divine guidance. As Daniel consecrated himself, God revealed mysteries and provided wisdom far beyond human understanding (Daniel 1)
2. **RESOURCES:** Supernatural provision and multiplication. When the widow consecrated her last meal to God's prophet, her resources were multiplied, and her household lacked nothing during the famine (1 Kings 17).
3. **RESPECT:** Divine honor and favor. As Joseph remained faithful to God, even in adversity, he earned respect and elevation to a position of influence in Egypt (Gen 41). A consecrated life attracts recognition and honor from both God and man.
4. **RELATIONSHIP:** Deep intimacy with God. Moses' consecration allowed him to speak with God "face to face" as a friend (Exod 33). Consecration draws us closer to God, strengthening our connection and aligning our hearts with His will.
5. **RESTORATION:** Renewal of what was lost. Job's unwavering consecration during his trials resulted in God restoring double of all he had lost (Job 42).
6. **REJOICING:** Joy and fulfillment in God's presence. As David consecrated himself through worship, he experienced joy and celebration, bringing the Ark of the Covenant to Jerusalem (2 Sam 6).

Spiritual GROWTH



At Victory in Christ Christian Center, we are deeply committed to fostering the spiritual growth and development of our church family. One of the most impactful resources that supports this mission is our Bible Training Center (BTC). This vital ministry arm of our church has been instrumental in equipping believers with the biblical knowledge, spiritual tools, and practical application needed to grow into mature, empowered disciples of Jesus Christ.

The Bible Training Center is more than a place of learning; it is a transformational hub where the Word of God comes alive in new and profound ways. Through carefully designed courses and teachings, BTC empowers our church family to:

1. Deepen Biblical Understanding:

The Bible tells us in 2 Timothy 2:15 (KJV), "Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth." BTC equips believers to study and understand the Word of God with clarity, enabling them to apply biblical principles to their daily lives.

2. Strengthen Faith and Spiritual Maturity:

Spiritual growth is essential for every believer, and BTC offers opportunities to explore topics that build unshakable intentional faith. By addressing foundational principles as well as advanced biblical truths, the center ensures that participants are constantly growing and thriving in their spiritual walk.

3. Equip for Kingdom Purpose:

We believe that every believer has a God-given purpose, and BTC plays a crucial role in helping individuals discover and step into their unique calling. 
