These are the words of God found in Malachi 3:5-6. A FEW UPDATES

We do have some updates to share with you as we continue to prepare for ministry in Quebec. Now that ministry in most places in our country is happening online we have been able to connect with our friends in Quebec in new ways. We have had the opportunity to meet with other missionaries that are planning on or are currently living in Quebec via Zoom. We have been invited to sit in on staff and all-leader meetings with our local church in Montreal. Sawyer has been able to be part of "zone enfants", a kids bible story time on Monday and Wednesday mornings. Finally we have been invited to meet with the "groupe de quartier" (community group) that is closest to where we are hoping to live in Montreal. We are grateful for these opportunities to grow in relationship with our friends in Quebec before we arrive.

Aaron has begun to work through the beginning stages of the Acts29/SEMBEQ training for church planters. There are twelve courses correlated with the twelve core competencies of church planters in the Acts29 assessment process. Much of these courses will happen in-context once we arrive, but for now he is able to begin working through the academic components.
