5 A simple summary (of what you read):

Even though Joseph is now a slave far from home, the God of his fathers is taking care of him, even when he is falsely accused and imprisoned. Wonderfully, his faith has not suffered because of his sufferings.

*-God blesses Joseph, whether he is a slave or prisoner. What kept Joseph from running away?
-God's favor on Joseph is clear to everyone around him.
-Though Potiphar's wife wants to use Joseph's garment as evidence against him, it's actually evidence of his righteousness.*



7 How this chapter points me to Jesus:

Joseph previews Jesus, since he too was wrongly suffered (ultimately, for the good of others). Though I am like Potiphar's wife, full of evil desires, through Christ's grace, I am forgiven and empowered to flee sin.
