Growth Groups! [Questions to Get You Talking]

- 1. Take a few minutes to talk about what ideas stood out to you from Sunday's message, or what questions you might have after hearing it.
- 2. In Acts 5, God releases Peter and the other apostles from unjust imprisonment under the Jewish leaders. Read Acts 5:25-29, 33-34, and 40-42 to learn what happened next (if you prefer, read the whole account in 5:12-42). How do we know the apostles had a God-centered focus as they experienced suffering? What could have been the result of their suffering? What was the result?
- 3. Though your suffering might differ from theirs, how might this story about Jesus' first followers encourage you in the hard and painful challenges you are facing/will face?

From Knowing to Showing

Take a minute to think about a difficult trial or painful challenge you are experiencing right now, or experienced recently. Based on what you've heard and read from God, how might He encourage you in light of your suffering? Write down several encouragements on note cards or on your phone and keep them close at hand.

Pointers for Parents

All of us deal with suffering, even our children. Think of a story from your life that you can share with your children to encourage them that God can and does use even our hardest times to pour out His greatest blessings.
