## Blindness and Belief (2/9/25)

Main Verses: Acts 28:23-28

Verse: Acts 28:26

'Takeaway': When others fail to respond to the Good News about Jesus, we should

remember that God has a plan, even when it comes to belief and unbelief.

Getting Started: Have you ever planned something? What did you do when it

worked out? When it didn't?

**READ:** Acts 28:23-28 (or have older kids help read).

## Some **OUESTIONS** to consider:

## Here are some **IMPORTANT IDEAS** we discover in these verses :

Toddler/PreK:

- Paul shared the gospel with the people from morning until evening, using the Scriptures to try to convince them.
- Some people responded in faith, believing in Jesus; others did not believe.
- God's own people, the Jews, did not believe. This opened the door for the Gentiles to hear and respond to the gospel. (see also Isaiah 6:9-10)
- Though their unbelief must have saddened Paul, he knew that God has had a perfect plan for redemption of his people since before he created the world. The people's response here did not catch God by surprise.

Elementary:

- Paul shared the gospel with the people from morning until evening, using the Scriptures to try to convince them.
- Some people responded in faith, believing in Jesus; others did not believe.
- God's own people, the Jews, did not believe. This opened the door for the Gentiles to hear and respond to the gospel. (see also Isaiah 6:9-10)
- Though their unbelief must have saddened Paul, he knew that God had a perfect plan for redemption of his people since before he created the world. The people's response here did not catch God by surprise.

## An **ENCOURAGEMENT** in light of God's word:

Toddler/PreK:

Talk to God. Thank him for his perfect plan for redemption for his people. Thank him that each of us has the privilege of sharing his love and grace with those around us. Talk to God when you feel sad that others don't believe, and ask him to help you this week to share his love and shine a light for him in all that you think, say, and do.

Elementary:

Talk to God. Thank him for his perfect plan for redemption for his people. Thank him that we have the privilege of sharing his good news with those around us. Talk to God when you feel sad that others don't believe, and ask him to help you share that Good News with those in your life - and to not be discouraged if they do not respond to it, knowing that God will move as he wills.
