

How Great is Our God (9/25/22)

Main Verses: Revelation 15:1-8

Key Verse: Revelation 15:3

'Takeaway': This big idea should lead us to worship: God is both King and Judge, and one day the whole world will know it.

Getting Started: What are some things God has done for you or your family?



READ 2 Peter 3:11-13 (or have older kids help read).

Some **QUESTIONS** to consider:

Toddler/PreK:

- What is worship?
- What do you know about Moses and crossing the Red Sea?
- How does God provide for his people?

Elementary:

- What is worship?
- What do you know about Moses and crossing the Red Sea? How did God provide for his people in that situation?
- How does God provide for his people?
- How should we respond to our great God?

Here are some **IMPORTANT IDEAS** we discover in these verses:

Toddler/PreK:

- The sign here (the seven angels) symbolizes another turning point in the war between God and Satan; here, it symbolizes God's final and ultimate victory!
- God is both King and Judge and one day the whole world will know and recognize Him.
- Just as God rescued the people from Egypt when he led Moses and his people through the Red Sea, those who know him through faith in Jesus will be safe from this final judgment. (Exodus 15)
- The only right response to our big God who delivers us is to **worship Him**. Those who oppose God will face judgment. Jesus (the Lamb) took the judgement for us, leading us to praise.

Elementary:

- The sign here (the seven angels) symbolizes another turning point in the war between God and Satan; here, it symbolizes God's final and ultimate victory!
- Just as God rescued the people from Egypt when he led Moses and his people through the Red Sea, those who know him through faith in Jesus will be safe from this final judgment. (Exodus 15)
- Jesus will come again and God will judge the world. As Moses's song in Exodus 15 says, God delivers the righteous and judges those who oppose Him.
- We all exist for the glory of God and to worship him alone.
- God ruling over and judging the whole world shows how big God is, which inspires worship of him, but also reminds us that Jesus (the Lamb) took the judgment for us which leads us to praise Him.

An **ENCOURAGEMENT** in light of God's word:

(Toddler/PreK) Talk to God, thanking him for how amazing and great he is! Thank him for winning the final victory over death. Praise him for his marvelous provision for us through Jesus his Son who took the judgment for our sin for us so we can know, love, and worship God forever.

(Elementary) Talk to God, thanking him for how amazing and great he is! Thank him that because of Jesus his Son, who took the judgment for our sin, those who know him through faith in Jesus will be safe from the final judgment. Thank God that because of Jesus we will be free to love and worship him for all eternity. Ask God to help you learn how to worship and honor him more each day as you grow in your knowledge of, and faith in, him.
