This week's story	Exodus 10:21 - 12:50 - "The Last Two Plagues: Darkness & The Passover"
Main takeaways	None of the terrible things that happened to the Egyptians happened to God's people, the Israelites, because they showed they were God's people and followed his instructions. In the middle of the dark, dark night, Pharaoh finally realized he couldn't win a contest against God. We don't need to sacrifice animals anymore because Jesus came to be the sacrifice for all our sins, for all time. He's our Savior, who takes care of us.
Potential questions	 What do you think it means to feel darkness? Do you think it was scary? Why don't you think Pharaoh listened to Moses? What do these verses in I John say about how Jesus takes care of us? How is Jesus's blood like the blood of the lamb on the Israelites' doorposts? (Jesus was called the Lamb of God, He died on the cross)






Israelite House

- Make the door open by cutting one side and the top of the door.


